Some fundamental questions to ask in order to know God as the One who Heals:

- Has God given you everything you need to succeed, or is God somehow holding out on you?
 - Genesis 3:6 (NIV 1984)
- 2. What story are you trying to tell the world?
 - Hebrews 12:1-4 (NIV 1984)
- 3. Are you really alone?
 - Hebrews 4:14-16 (NIV 1984)

When we get wounded, we can ask "Why?" all day long, but in the end the better question is "What now?"

John 5:5-6 (NIV 1984)

"One who was there had been an invalid for thirty-eight years. When Jesus saw him lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a long time, he asked him, 'Do you want to get well?'"

Questions to Consider:

- 1. Identify a passage of Scripture to share with your family, friends, or small group.
- 2. What could be some reasons why God chose to reveal Himself as 'Healer'?
- 3. How does this change your understanding of God?
