1 Peter 5:5-6 (NIV) 5 "In the same way, you who are younger, submit yourselves to your elders. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, 'God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble.' 6 Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that He may lift you up in due time."

- Humility is an action and is rewarded.
- God gives grace to the humble.
 - Not the righteous.
 - Not the strong.
 - Not the wise.
- How Daniel showed humility
 - He has an accurate view of himself. (Daniel 1:4-5)
 - The way he asked those in authority. (Daniel 1:8-14)
 - How he submitted to godless authority. (Daniel 1:18-20)
 - The way he honored the evil king. (Daniel 2:31, 37; 4:19, etc.)
 - o How he consistently pointed to God.

The need to _____ Humility

- The Enemy hates humility.
- Our World hates humility.
- Biblical Humility is **not** self-hate, self-belittling, or low self-esteem.
- Biblical Humility is an accurate view of self.
 - Romans 12:3 (NLT) "Don't think you are better than you really are. Be honest in your evaluation of yourselves."
 - o It is dealing with **your** hurts, habits, and hang-ups. (Matthew 7:1-5)
 - o It is **not** downplaying your accomplishments.

- Romans 13:1-2 (NLT) "Everyone must submit to governing authorities. For all authority comes from God, and those in positions of authority have been placed there by God. ² So anyone who rebels against authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and they will be punished."
- Hebrews 5:7-8 (NLT) "7 While Jesus was here on earth, He offered prayers and pleadings, with a loud cry and tears, to the One who could rescue Him from death. And God heard His prayers because of His deep reverence for God. 8 Even though Jesus was God's Son, He learned obedience from the things He suffered."

- Prayer. (Matthew 6:9-13)
- God's Word. (Hebrews 4:12-13)
- Confess sins to God and others. (1 John 1:9; James 5:16)
- Do life with other believers. (Proverbs 27:17)
