Paul's Final Days

- **1.** We hand things off or down to others intentionally and unintentionally.
 - God's desire is to redeem people back to Himself.
 - God cares most for people. 16 times in Scripture, starting in **Genesis 16** and finishing in **Revelation** it says, "I will be their God, and they will be my people."
- 2. God has always used His Spirit through His people to hand off His redeeming message (*Acts 1:8, 2 Timothy 4:6-7*).
- **3.** How we live a resurrected life is the best way to hand off His redeeming message (*1 Corinthians* 9:24-26).
 - Be coachable and pliable. As followers of Christ, we are to allow the Master Artist to chisel away anything in our lives that doesn't look like Christ. (Ephesians 5:1-2, Philippians 2:1-11)
 - Run a different race than the world would have you run. This is what will get handed down (*Matthew 7:13-14*).
 - When the race gets hard, how we respond is key to what gets handed down (*Philippians* 1:12-14).
 - $\circ\;$ Respond by faith in difficult circumstances.
 - In Christ, our circumstances do not dictate our joy; our relationship with and hope in Christ does.
 - We need others to not only run the race but to intentionally hand it off (*Philippians 2:19-20, 25, 4:21-23*).
 - Build authentic and genuine Christ centered relationships (*Philippians 4:21-22, Ephesians 6:21-22*).
 - Being intentional to entrust the responsibility of Christ's message to trustworthy people who will hand it down (2 *Timothy 2:2*).

Conclusion: Be focused on the ultimate goal which is to experience a resurrected life instead of just reading about a resurrected story (*Philippians 3:7-14*).

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
