## EXILES: A HOLY NATION (Week 3)

**1 Peter 2:9-10 (NIV)** But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light. <sup>10</sup>Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

## **OUR SPIRITUAL IDENTITY:**

• We are a chosen people.

**1 Peter 1:3 (ESV)** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to His great mercy, He has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

- We are a royal priesthood we have been born again into new people and connected to a new family, a kingdom of believers.
- We are a holy nation We represent God to man and intercede for man to God.
- We are God's special possession God's desire has always been to use people set apart for Him to reach lost people.

**Exodus 19:5-6 (NIV)** Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, <sup>6</sup> you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites.

**Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)** For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good thingsHe planned for us long ago.

## **OUR PURPOSE AS THE CHURCH:**

**1 Peter 2:9 (NIV)** that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light.

- We exist to make much of the ONE who has chosen us, forgiven us and redeemed us.
- We are to declare the goodness of God in words and deeds. How are we to live as God's holy nation in 2025-2026?

**1 Peter 2:11-17 (NIV)** Dear friends, I urge you, as foreigners and exiles, to abstain from sinful desires, which wage war against your soul. <sup>12</sup> Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day He visits us. <sup>13</sup> Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every human authority: whether to the emperor, as the supreme authority, <sup>14</sup> or to governors, who are sent by Him to punish those who do wrong and to commend those who do right. <sup>15</sup> For it is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish people. <sup>16</sup> Live as free people, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; live as God's slaves. <sup>17</sup> Show proper respect to everyone, love the family of believers, fear God, honor the emperor.

- Remember our citizenship and identity.
- We are to abstain from sinful desires.
- We are exhorted to live good lives among the world.
- We are to submit to human authority for the Lord's sake.
- We are to pray for our authorities.

**1 Timothy 2:1-4 (NLT)** I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf and give thanks for them. <sup>2</sup> Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. <sup>3</sup> This is good and pleases God our Savior, <sup>4</sup> who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

• We are to be ambassadors of Christ.

**2 Corinthians 5:18-21 (NIV)** All this is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: <sup>19</sup> that God was reconciling the world to Himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And He has committed to us the message of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup> We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. <sup>21</sup> God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.

• Ambassadors represent the values, policies and leadership of the nation they come from.

**Colossians 3:12-14 (NIV)** Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. <sup>13</sup> Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. <sup>14</sup> And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

- Who needs your compassion and not your judgment?
- How will you show kindness to the person in your life who is most difficult?
- How will you be gentle and patient with someone who disagrees with you?
