1. Jesus' work is done.

- He died for the sins of men. It is finished.
- He showed us what maturity looks like.
- He made disciples, messengers.

• He sent the Holy Spirit to empower the messengers.

2. Saul is converted.

- Saul introduced. Stephen plants a seed.
- Saul persecutes the church. (Acts 9)
- Saul, Saul why do you persecute me? The church is the body of Christ.
- God uses believers to share the message. Ananias baptizes Saul/Paul.
- Suffering for Jesus is a part of being a Christian.
- The Christians in Damascus sneak him out of the town.
- Later Barnabas brings Paul to the disciples.
- Paul set apart for the ministry.
- Acts 7:57–58; 8:1–3; 9:4–7; 9:15.
- Matthew 16:24–27.

3. Saul/Paul's ministry.

- A. Paul's desire was to bring glory to Jesus not himself.
- B. Paul's job was to give the message of Jesus. The good news.
 - Why don't people share their faith?
 - They don't understand the reality being lost or saved. Only two categories.
 - They don't feel they have anything others really need. They are not living a resurrected life.
 - Fear of rejection.
 - Not sure how.
- C. Paul's job was to be persistent even in the face of opposition.
 - Why do people quit when it gets tough?
 - They don't understand the world we are in. A war is going on.
 - They have not matured.
 - They believe God doesn't care or can't use what seems like failures.
 - Acts 14:8–20
