- Daniel didn't just have humility. He showed humility.
- o Incredibly respectful—even after the lion's den! (Daniel 1:8-14, 2:26-7, 6:19-22)
- How God wants us to respond:

**2 Timothy 2:24-26** (NIV) <sup>24</sup>The Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged, <sup>25</sup>with gentleness correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God may grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth, <sup>26</sup>and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will.

- Show proper respect to everyone. (1 Peter 2:17)
- No one likes or listens to people who don't like to listen to them!

### 3) Wisdom

- There's a big difference between what we don't \_\_\_\_\_ and what God \_\_\_\_\_.
  - It's amazing what Daniel didn't fight over. (pagan education, pagan name, serving a godless king...)
- Pick your battles!
  - o If asked to sin, stand firm! (Proverbs 9:10)
  - o But if it's not a sin, let it go! Non-believers need Jesus, not our moral code. (1 Corinthians 5:9-13)
