Topic: I Told You So! – The Birth of Christ

Reading: Isaiah 9:6

1. Read the following Old Testament prophecies about Christ's birth and the corresponding New Testament fulfillment. In the space provided, share the key event that is prophesied:

Old Testament Prophecy	New Testament Fulfillment	Key Event
Isaiah 7:14	Matthew 1:20-22	
Micah 5:2	Matthew 2:3-6	
Hosea 11:1	Matthew 2:14-15	
Jeremiah 31:15	Matthew 2:16-18	

2. Matthew 2:23 states that the prophets prophesied that Jesus would be called a Nazarene – apparently referring to him being born on the “wrong side of the tracks” and “looked down upon”. How might this speak to someone who had a challenging upbringing? (See Hebrews 4:15.)

3. Read Isaiah 9:6. Below are the four titles given to Jesus. Explain in your own words how these titles of Christ may be important to you:

- Wonderful Counselor -
- Mighty God -
- Everlasting Father -
- Prince of Peace -

4. There are other prophecies about the birth of Christ, such as the star that the Magi followed (Numbers 24:17), and Christ being a descendent of David (Jeremiah 23:5-6). With all these fulfilled prophecies recorded in Scripture, why do you think people still reject Jesus as the Messiah? (See Luke 16:31.) Have you made a decision to follow Jesus?
