## Lesson

John 6:1-14

A large crowd had followed Jesus because they saw the miracles he had performed healing the sick. The people were hungry but they had no food to feed them. One of the disciples, Andrew, noticed that there was a boy with five barley loaves and two fish. Jesus told the disciples to have the people sit down. Then, he took the loaves and gave thanks.
