Topic: God In Three Persons – What Is the Trinity?

Reading: Colossians 2:9; John 17:20-23

1. Read Colossians 2:9. What does Paul mean when he states that we find all the fullness of the “Godhead” or “Deity” in Jesus Christ? (See John 1:1, 14, 18.)

2. The definition of the Trinity is *One God in Three Persons*. Those three *Persons* are Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. How important is each member of the Trinity for your salvation? (See I Peter 1:2.)

3. In John 17:23, Jesus prays that we may be one as He and the Father are one. How is the Body of Christ supposed to operate in this unity? (See I Corinthians 12:12-26.)

4. Read Ephesians 4:3. What are we to challenged to pursue? According to this verse, which member of the Trinity empowers us pursue this goal?

5. Read II Peter 1:4. We are invited to be in relationship with the Triune God. What does it mean for you to be relationship with the Triune God?

6. Read Genesis 1:26-27. When God said, “Let us...”, who is the *us*? (Hint: God is Three Persons.) Note also that the only time this phrase is mentioned in Creation is when God creates mankind. What does this say about the Triune God's relationship to humanity?
