Topic: Better – Jesus the Better Messiah

Reading: Hebrews chapter 11-13

1. Read Hebrews 11:1. According to this verse, what is the definition of faith?

2. Read Hebrews 12:1-3. This passage states that we have a “great cloud of witnesses” (the members of the Hall of Faith in chapter 11) essentially cheering us on for the “race marked out for us”. In order to win this race, we must get rid of something and concentrate on another (verses 1-2). What must we throw off and what must we fix our eyes upon?

3. Read Hebrews 12:5-11. When we are disciplined by God, what does this prove (verse 6)? How did our fathers/parents discipline us (verse 10a)? Ultimately, why does God through Jesus our Better Messiah allow trials and suffering (verse 10b)?

4. Read Hebrews 13:5. What is God's promise to you regardless of how hard life may get? If you are feeling tempted to drift from the faith, how might this verse help you?

5. Read Hebrews 13:8. What does this say about Jesus Christ? What does this say about the character of Christ regardless of our situation, our faith, our obedience, or even the COVID-19 crisis?

6. Read Hebrews 13:24. Since Pastor Mike is one of your spiritual leaders and is Italian, who sends you his greetings and welcomes yours as well :)?
