

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: GOD MADE ME SPECIAL

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:

DRIVING:

Talk about your car, and all of the special parts that make it up – engine, seats, door, steering wheel. Remind them that our bodies are made up of many different parts. God's people – The body of Christ – is also made up of different parts, the many people who love and follow God.

🕷 PLAYING:

Get out the building blocks and build a person. Talk about the parts of the body and the special job that each of them do.

EATING:

During your mealtime prayer, thank God for making your little ones special. During the meal, encourage them by listing some of the traits and talents that make them special.

SNUGGLING:

Hold your little ones close and let them know how special they are. Thank them for something special they did for you or someone else during that day.
