Excellence is putting your faith into action.

The Jews saw excellence as what was seen outwardly.

Same as in today's culture.

Jesus called the Pharisees phonies. Matthew 23:27-28

Christianity takes what the world sees as excellent and flips it upside down from outside to inside.

It is vital to put your faith into action when operating in a fallen, sinful, world.

Philippians 3:12-14

Matthew 10:16-20

Paul was given the opportunity to share with boldness about the unknown God when he was speaking in the temple of idols in Athens. Acts 17:22-31.

Every time Paul testified before these rulers, Ceasars, or kings he would share with *great courage* his testimony of how Christ saved him and appointed him as an apostle to go out to all the nations and share the good news of Jesus Christ.

You never know what the Lord will do when you step out in obedience and *Put Your Faith Into Action*.

What does scripture say about being influenced by Satan? 2 Timothy 2:26b

Paul calls those who are not in Christ *captives* of Satan.

"There are no mere mortals, every person you encounter is either an eternal splendor or an immortal horror." - C.S. Lewis

Two key principles to putting your faith into action:

A) Excellent faith requires you being willing to give up to go up.

What did Paul give up? Philippians 3:4-11

B) Excellent faith requires you must learn and understand the will of God. Galatians 1:15-16b

Galatians 1:23-24

2 Areas that Paul deals with in seeking the prize of the upward call in Jesus Christ:

1) Doing God's Will equates to finding purpose and meaning

1 Corinthians 9:25

2) Dealing with failures of the past allows you to be free to perform God's will.

Jesus' final address to the Apostles: Matthew 28:18-20

The King of Kings and Lord of Lords is with you. Do not be afraid to take a step of faith and see how He uses you!
