1) The Lust of the Flesh, vs. 3-4

Satan’s purpose is to deceive you about God’s purpose for your life.

2) The Pride of Life, Vs. 5-6

Satan’s purpose is to twist God’s word to deceive you.

This sin deals with the area of presumption.

The pride of life is often seen when you hear one side of a story and believe it without ever asking about the other side.

3) The Lust of the Eyes, Vs. 8-10

Satan’s purpose is to get you to take a shortcut because you deserve it now.
