Christ Alone is Savior

As Savior, Christ is our Substitute

“He who knew no sin was **made to be sin for us** that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”

“For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, **the just for the unjust**, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit” 1 Peter 3:18

*Bearing shame and scoffing rude,
In my place condemned He stood;
Sealed my pardon with His blood.
Hallelujah! What a Savior!*

As Savior, Christ is the Father’s Satisfaction

The propitiation for our sins
He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied

We are forgiven and justified on the merit of Christ alone.

“God was in Christ reconciling the world unto himself”

In Christ, God has accomplished all this is necessary to eliminate his enmity with us, his wrath towards us. The death of Jesus Christ in the place of sinners is primarily about God – not us – “that HE might be just, and the justifier of him that believeth on Jesus.”

Christ Alone is Sovereign

Christ Alone is Superior

To creation: John 1:3; Colossians 1:17
To angels: Hebrews 1:5ff

Christ is superior because He is equal with God – in fact, IS God:
Philippians 2:6

Because He is God, He is to be worshipped as God:

“Let all the angels of God worship him”

“Every knee shall bow, every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord”

Revelation 5:11-13; 7:9-12
