

The Glory of God Alone

Romans 11:33-36; 16:27

The glory of God is the manifestation of his person and presence:

Moses's meeting with God: Exodus 24:7

His face shone with the impress of the glory of God

The Tabernacle: Exodus 40:34

The Creation: Psalm 19:1

Isaiah 6: "The whole earth is full of his glory"

Man was created to reflect the glory of God: 1 Cor 11:7

Man has fallen short of the glory of God: Romans 3:23

God devises a plan to rescue fallen man for his own glory: Eph 1:6, 12, 14

God's glory resides in the person of Jesus Christ: John 1:14; Matthew 17

"There came a voice from the most excellent glory saying..."

Angels at Jesus' birth: "the glory of the Lord shone round about them"

"The light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ" 2 Cor 4:6

"The radiance of his glory" Hebrews 1:3

Raised to life by the glory of the father: Romans 6:4

Our whole lives are to reflect the glory of God: 1 Cor 10:31

To give God alone the glory is to recognize his presence in the routine of our lives and to praise him.
