Trump heading to Jerusalem on Sunday - says 1st stage of 'historic & unprecedented' peace deal is done

He is expected to meet with Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and deliver a major address to the Knesset – Israel's parliament – in Jerusalem.

Egyptian President Abdel Fattah el-Sisi has invited Trump to visit Egypt, given that the final round of negotiations took place in the Red Sea resort of Sharm el-Sheikh, and that two years of talks have been conducted in Cairo.

However, at this point, there is no indication from the White House that Trump will visit Egypt.

Rather, he wants to speak directly to the people of Israel – America's most trusted and faithful ally in the region and the target of Iran's seven-front war.

"I am expected to arrive in Israel in the coming days," Trump told a reporter for Axios News.

"They want me to speak in the Knesset, and I will definitely do so if they want it that way."

"My conversation with Bibi was great. He is happy – and rightfully so. This is a big achievement. The whole world rallied to reach this agreement, including countries that were previously enemies."

From the White House, Trump announced at 5:06 p.m. Mountain Time on Wednesday that his negotiators had achieved a dramatic breakthrough in Sharm.

Cabinet set to approve hostage-ceasefire deal after Israel, Hamas sign on in Egypt  
Trump expects hostages to return Monday or Tuesday, as negotiators finalize list of 250 Palestinian life-sentence prisoners, 1,700 Gazan detainees that Israel will free in return

Israel and Hamas negotiators on Thursday signed a deal in Egypt to secure the return of all 48 hostages held by terror groups in Gaza, of whom some 20 are believed to be alive, in exchange for some 2,000 Palestinian security prisoners, a partial Israeli withdrawal, and a ceasefire.

“The final draft of phase one was signed this morning in Egypt by all parties to release all of the hostages,” said a spokeswoman for Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu’s office.

The security cabinet convened around 6:30 p.m., after an unexplained hour-and-a-half delay, for a briefing about the deal, to be followed by a full cabinet vote. The deal is expected to handily pass, despite some opposition from the far right.

Hamas publishes:

“God, let the ceasefire be like the Treaty of Hudaibiyyah — followed by conquest, like the conquest of Mecca.”

(Context: The Treaty of Hudaibiyyah was a temporary peace agreement signed by Muhammad with the Quraysh tribe, which he later broke before conquering Mecca. The statement implies that Hamas views the ceasefire as a tactical pause before a future “victory” or takeover.)

AI Is Now A Debt Bubble Too, Quietly Surpassing All Banks To Become The Largest Sector In The Market

Last week we published a lengthy article discussing in detail the current generation's (because every generation has one, just ask Global Crossing) "infinite money" circle jerk circular deals which have become the de jour staple of the AI bubble and which, simplified, look something like this...

Lots and lots of debt, because with negligible enterprise penetration and the biggest use case so far being a \$19.99 monthly subscription for lazy college students who are outsourcing their essay writing to some chatbot, someone has to pay for the \$500 billion in annual capex.

We forecast roughly \$2.9 trillion of global data center spend through 2028, comprising \$1.6 trillion on hardware (chips/servers) and \$1.3 trillion on building data center infrastructure, including real estate, build costs, and maintenance.

This translates into investment needs of over \$900 billion in 2028. For context, the total capex spending by all companies in the S&P 500 index combined was about \$950 billion in 2024.

Such large potential spending has significant macro consequences as well. Our economists expect that investment spending related to data center construction and power generation will add up to 40bp to US real GDP growth between 2025-26.
