Trump Says Iran Deal Could End Hormuz Conflict, Warns Military Strikes Will Resume if Talks Collapse

President Donald Trump said Wednesday that the ongoing military confrontation involving Iran and the Strait of Hormuz could come to an end if Tehran accepts a new U.S.-backed proposal designed to halt fighting, reopen critical shipping lanes, and restart nuclear negotiations.

In a statement posted to Truth Social, Trump said the proposed agreement would bring an end to “Operation Epic Fury” and allow maritime traffic to resume through the strategic waterway if Iran complies with the terms currently under discussion. “Assuming Iran agrees to give what has been agreed to, which is, perhaps, a big assumption, the already legendary Epic Fury will be at an end, and the highly effective Blockade will allow the Hormuz Strait to be OPEN TO ALL, including Iran,” Trump wrote.

The president also warned that military operations would escalate if Tehran rejects the proposal.

“If they don’t agree, the bombing starts, and it will be, sadly, at a much higher level and intensity than it was before,” Trump stated.

According to reporting from Axios and Reuters, the emerging framework centers on a one-page, 14-point memorandum of understanding that would temporarily freeze the conflict while creating a 30-day negotiating window for a broader peace and nuclear agreement.

US, Iran launch new attacks as they wrestle for control of Gulf waters

A fragile truce in the Middle East was under strain on Tuesday after the U.S. and Iran exchanged fire in the Gulf as they wrestled for control of the Strait of Hormuz. Iran's parliament speaker, Mohammad Baqer Qalibaf, said in a social media post on Tuesday breaches of the four-week-old ceasefire by the United States and its allies had endangered shipping and energy transit through the vital waterway.

"We know well that the continuation of the current situation is unbearable for the United States, while we have not even begun yet," he said.

The fresh volleys of missiles and drones came after U.S. President Donald Trump launched a new effort to get stranded tankers and other ships through the strait, the vital energy-trade chokepoint that has been virtually closed since the U.S. and Israel began attacks on Iran in February, a war that has killed thousands of people across the region.

"Working with all sides to turn commitment into concrete actions," the high representative for Gaza tweeted.

High Representative for Gaza Nickolay Mladenov said he held a "positive and substantive discussion" with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu in Jerusalem on Tuesday.

Participants in the meeting "reaffirmed our commitment to the full implementation" of U.S. President Donald Trump's 20-point peace plan for the Strip, the Board of Peace official wrote in a post on X.

"Working with all sides to turn commitment into concrete actions. This will require decisions for progress," Mladenov added. "We keep moving forward in the interest of a better future for Israelis and Palestinians."

The Israeli Prime Minister's Office did not immediately provide a readout of Tuesday's meeting, which was also attended by U.S. Ambassador to Israel Mike Huckabee, senior Trump administration official Aryeh Lightstone and Liran Tancman, an Israeli tech entrepreneur who is advising the Board of Peace on a volunteer basis, according to a picture distributed by the PMO.

Tony Blair, a founding member of the Board of Peace, told the U.N Security Council last week that the organization had made "substantial progress" in implementing Trump's peace plan.

Romanian socialists and far right topple government

The key NATO member on Europe's eastern edge faces fresh upheaval with an economic crisis looming.

Romania's centrist government collapsed on Tuesday, throwing one of Europe's most strategically important countries into turmoil at a critical time.

Center-right Prime Minister Ilie Bolojan, who heads the National Liberal Party, lost a confidence vote in the country's parliament after only 10 months in office, bringing his short-lived and unpopular attempt to rein in the country's budget deficit to an abrupt end.

The European Union's sixth most populous country — and a key NATO member bordering Ukraine — now faces an uncertain future as it seeks to stave off the threat of an economic crisis in the months ahead.

Christian YouTubers in Germany could face prison for 'Islam is not peace' video

Hamburg prosecutors are investigating two Christian YouTubers for allegedly 'insulting' Islam in a video criticizing religious calls for the killing of Jews within Muslim texts.

Two Christian YouTubers in Germany are being investigated by the Public Prosecutor's Office for criticizing Islam.

The Hamburg Public Prosecutor's Office is investigating two Christian YouTubers for criticizing Islamic "anti-Semitism" and Islamic religious texts in a YouTube video that had between 600 and 1,000 views before it was taken offline.

According to the authorities, their statements are alleged to have violated the ban on "insulting religious denominations, religious communities, and ideological associations."

The maximum sentence under section 166 of the Criminal Code regarding insults to religious groups is three years in prison. However, these cases are usually punished by fines rather than prison time.

Hateful anti-Israel mob descends on historic NYC synagogue, clashes with cops in rowdy protest

A hateful mob of keffiyeh-clad anti-Israel protesters flooded the streets near a historic Manhattan synagogue Tuesday night — clashing with cops as they repeatedly shouted, "Israel should not exist."

About 100 agitators waving Palestinian flags and banging drums swarmed about a half-block from Park East Synagogue, chanting, "Palestine will never die" and "Stop the sale of stolen land" during an event promoting real estate in Israel and the West Bank, according to shocking footage.

While the East 67th Street synagogue was sealed off by police barricades, footage captured the rowdy protesters clashing with cops who were trying to force their way past the barriers into the street.

FULL DISCLOSURE UFO files release coming ‘very soon,’ Kash Patel says – as pastors warned Americans may ‘abandon faith over revelations’

AMERICANS are being told to brace for incoming UFO disclosures – but some faith leaders fear that the information could shake believers’ views of the Bible.

The warning comes as the Trump administration prepares to release long-secret files on UFOs and possible alien life, according to FBI director Kash Patel.

Patel has said that documents tied to unidentified aerial phenomena, or UAPs, are expected to be made public “very soon.”

Patel made the comments during a wide-ranging appearance on Sean Hannity’s podcast, released on Tuesday.

“[Trump] stood up an interagency process with the Department of War leading that effort to get out the documentation,” Patel said.

“They’re going to be publicly releasing this information very soon. We are all for it,” he added.

“President Trump listens to what the American public has an interest in,” Patel added.

“He’s got to do a million different things at once, and he still has the time to say, ‘Stand up an organization, the American public wants a document.’ We’ve already delivered the documents, they’re coming out — that’s it.”

Donald Trump signed a February 19 executive order directing agencies to release government records on UFOs and extraterrestrial life.

Trump also teased last week that the first files would contain some “very interesting” information.

No new government UFO files have yet been released.

But some Christian leaders claim they have already been warned to prepare followers for what could come next.

Tennessee evangelist Perry Stone claimed pastors were invited to a secret meeting with US intelligence officials about the coming disclosures.

Stone said the meeting involved a small group of pastors with large followings in the Christian community.

He claimed they were told the government could release reports and possible videos of aliens and spacecraft “not from this planet.”

In an April 27 YouTube video, Stone said the alleged briefing included claims about “reptilian” creatures, UFOs, and material of non-human origin.

He said some of the claims sounded like “something out of a sci-fi movie.”

Stone warned that the information could make some Christians question the creation story.

“You’re going to have people who are going to say if there are galaxies and there are allegedly other creations in the galaxies, then the whole creation story is a myth,” he said.

e claimed some believers could “apostatize and turn from the Christian faith because they have no answer for what they’re about to hear.”

Stone also said pastors were warned that non-Christians may panic and turn to churches for answers.

“They’re going to freak out and they’re going to come to pastors, ministers, and teachers and say, ‘What is this? Is this really real?’” he said.

Evangelist and podcaster Tony Merkel also claimed officials were worried about the impact of UFO disclosures on organized religion.

“I came in contact with these guys more than a year ago now,” Merkel said.

He said their goal was “to prepare the body of Christ for what’s coming.
