US military turns around 6 ships, 'completely' halts trade from Iran's ports amid blockade

The U.S. military on Tuesday said it has turned six ships around in its effort to “completely” halt trade from Iran’s ports — the first effort since President Trump imposed a blockade on the Strait of Hormuz.

Within the first 24 hours of the blockade, six merchant vessels complied with U.S. forces to turn around to re-enter an Iranian port in the Gulf of Oman, U.S. Central Command (Centcom) wrote in a post on social platform X. This included two oil tankers that departed from Chabahar Port, Reuters reported.

Centcom commander Adm. Brad Cooper said in a statement that the blockade of Iranian ports “has been fully implemented as U.S. forces maintain maritime superiority in the Middle East.”

“An estimated 90% of Iran’s economy is fueled by international trade by sea,” Cooper continued. “In less than 36 hours since the blockade was implemented, U.S. forces have completely halted economic trade going into and out of Iran by sea.”

Centcom previously stated that no ships passed the blockade within its first 24 hours. But two U.S.-sanctioned Chinese ships have passed through the strait, the medium-range tanker Rich Starry and the tanker Murlikishan. Both ships are in the Persian Gulf as of Wednesday morning, according to shipping data from Kpler.

More than 15 countries planning to facilitate Strait of Hormuz access, Macron says

French President Emmanuel Macron said about 15 countries were planning to facilitate the resumption of traffic through the Strait of Hormuz, through which a fifth of the world's oil supply usually flows, after a ceasefire between the United States and Iran was announced.

"About 15 countries are currently mobilised and are participating in the planning, under France's leadership, to enable the implementation of this strictly defensive mission in coordination with Iran to facilitate the resumption of traffic," Macron said on Wednesday, speaking at the start of his meeting on defence with advisers and members of his cabinet.

Macron said he welcomed the ceasefire between Iran and the United States, but added the situation in Lebanon remained critical and called for Lebanon to be included in the deal. France maintains close ties with Lebanon, a former protectorate.

"Our wish in this context is to be assured that the ceasefire fully includes Lebanon," Macron said.

Israel and Lebanon agree to 10-day ceasefire, Trump says

The leaders of Israel and Lebanon agreed to a 10-day ceasefire after officials from the two countries met in Washington, President Donald Trump said Thursday.

The temporary truce will start at 5 p.m. ET, Trump said in a Truth Social post.

In a follow-up, Trump added that he will be inviting Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and President Joseph Aoun of Lebanon to the White House “for the first meaningful talks between Israel and Lebanon since 1983, a very long time ago.”

“Both sides want to see PEACE, and I believe that will happen, quickly!” Trump wrote.

The developments add to growing hopes of a deal to end the Middle East war, which the U.S. and Israel launched against Iran on Feb. 28.

Over 130 Hezbollah weapons found in southern Lebanon school, IDF says

IDF troops operating in southern Lebanon uncovered more than 130 weapons inside a school in the Bint Jbeil area, the military says.

The discovery was made by Givati Brigade forces, which the military says are continuing targeted ground operations against Hezbollah infrastructure.

According to the IDF, the cache included Kalashnikov rifles, pistols and other firearms. Troops also found Hezbollah flags and insignia at the site.

Give cease-fire a chance, Erdoğan says, as he warns against Israel

President Erdoğan on Wednesday renewed Türkiye's commitment to the cease-fire in the U.S.-Israel-Iran war while he urged the sides to seize the opportunity after the Islamabad talks and warned Israel was 'unhappy' with the process

President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan on Wednesday urged the parties in the U.S.-Israel-Iran war to proceed with cease-fire talks. “You can’t negotiate with clenched fists; the window of opportunity for a cease-fire should be taken advantage of,” he told the parliamentary group meeting of his Justice and Development Party (AK Party) in Ankara.

“Israel is not satisfied with the cease-fire. It should not be allowed to undermine the process,” he said.

Erdoğan also hit back at the Israeli administration, particularly Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, who insulted the Turkish president on social media. “Nobody can wag a finger at Türkiye,” he said.

The Turkish leader said that Türkiye is making the "necessary appeals and initiatives" to reduce tensions, extend the cease-fire, and continue talks over the U.S. and Israeli attacks on Iran.

"The Israeli government, which is known to be unhappy with the cease-fire process, must not be allowed to sabotage it," Erdoğan added.

Erdoğan also praised Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez, saying he "congratulates from the heart my dear friend Sanchez, who has taken a firm stance against the threats of butcher Netanyahu in Gaza."

Regarding regional stability, he said: "If there is to be peace in our region, it will be despite the Zionist regime. If stability is achieved, it will again be despite the Israeli government."

Iraqi parliament elects Nizar Amedi as country's new president

Iraq's parliament has elected Kurdish politician Nizar Amedi as the new president. Amedi, a former environment minister, has led the Patriotic Union of Kurdistan's political office in Baghdad since 2024.

Now, Iraq must select a new prime minister, a sensitive choice due to U.S. concerns over former Prime Minister Nouri al-Maliki's nomination by Iranian-backed Shi'ite coalitions. U.S. President Trump has threatened to withdraw support if Maliki is chosen.

Amidst rising tensions, senior U.S. and Iranian officials are engaging in high-level talks in Islamabad. Iraq's political structure requires a Shi'ite prime minister, a Sunni parliamentary speaker, and a Kurdish president.

Sharia courts bill sparks urgent religious freedom concerns

International and Ugandan religious freedom advocates are calling for the rejection of a bill that would establish a nationwide system of Sharia courts in Uganda, warning that lawmakers are pushing to fast-track its passage before Parliament dissolves later this month.

Parliament dissolves on April 24, with the Qadhis Courts Bill expected to be formally introduced and moved into committee within days, according to the legal advocacy group ADF International, which has called on parliamentarians to reject the measure.

Under the proposed system, if a Muslim files a family, custody or inheritance dispute in a Qadhis court, any Christian or other non-Muslim party to that case would lose the right to seek resolution in Uganda's civil court system. Appeals to Uganda's High Court would be limited to panels composed of a Muslim judge and four Muslim scholars, with no further recourse available.

“We are very concerned at the Qadhis Courts Bill, which will require Christians and other non-Muslims to appear before Sharia courts, and formally introduce religious law into our national law,” said Arthur Ayorekire, vice president of the Uganda Christian Lawyers’ Fraternity. “The bill is not necessary and will only lead to legal uncertainty, tensions between religious groups, and potentially will allow extremism to grab a hold in Uganda.”

ADF International pointed out that the bill raises concerns about religious conversion. Sharia law does not recognize conversion from Islam, and under the proposed courts, Muslim individuals seeking to convert to Christianity or other religions would likely be prevented from doing so.

Is King Charles III leading the Church of England away from its roots and into Islam?

This Easter, the man who swore at his coronation to be Fidei Defensor, Defender of the Faith, had nothing to say. King Charles III, Supreme Governor of the Church of England, issued no Easter message to the hundreds of millions of Christians in the United Kingdom and across the Commonwealth. He did, however, find time in February to wish Muslims a “blessed and peaceful Ramadan,” opening his message with “As-salaamu alaikum“, “peace be upon you” in Arabic, and posting it to the official Royal Family account alongside a graphic reading “Ramadan Mubarak.”

Buckingham Palace confirmed that King Charles would not be releasing an Easter message in 2026, just two months after wishing Muslims a “happy Ramadan.” The Palace defended the omission by noting that, unlike the Christmas broadcast, an Easter message from the monarch is not an established annual tradition. Royal expert Richard Fitzwilliams acknowledged the historical point but called the decision “a mistake.” “The King did give a special message to celebrate Ramadan this year. It would therefore surely have been appropriate to have delivered one for Easter, as the controversy over this is one which could and should have been avoided,” Fitzwilliams told Fox News Digital.

Cuba ‘ready’ for possible US attack: president

Cuban President Miguel Diaz-Canel said Thursday his country was “ready” for a possible US attack on the communist island following months of mounting pressure from President Donald Trump.

“We don’t want that (confrontation) but it is our duty to be ready to avoid it, and if it were unavoidable, to win it,” Diaz-Canel told thousands of people attending a rally in Havana to mark the 65th anniversary of the failed US invasion of the island at the Bay of Pigs.

Cuba has been bracing for a possible attack following repeated warnings from Trump that Cuba is “next” after he toppled Venezuela’s leader Nicolas Maduro and went to war against Iran.

Speculation Explodes Following Disappearance Of 10th Expert With UFO And Nuclear Secrets

Following the revelation that yet another government contractor with links to nuclear secrets and suspected dark project UAP information has vanished, speculation as to what exactly is going on has massively intensified.

The case of Steven Garcia, a 48-year-old property custodian at the Kansas City National Security Campus in Albuquerque, New Mexico, marks the latest entry in a disturbing sequence of deaths and vanishings among individuals connected to NASA, nuclear weapons components, and sensitive aerospace research.

Los Angeles Magazine contributor Lauren Conlin joined “Jesse Weber Live” to discuss the case, noting its eerie parallels to prior incidents.

Garcia was last seen leaving his Albuquerque home on foot on August 28, 2025, carrying only a handgun. He left behind his phone, keys, wallet, and car. Officials have described him as potentially a danger to himself, but no trace has been found in the remote area where he lived.

Conlin emphasized the chilling similarities during the NewsNation segment. “This one is chilling to me because, as you said it echoes Neal McCasland’s disappearance. It was like the same thing in the state of New Mexico,” she stated. McCasland, a retired Air Force major general with deep UFO community ties, vanished from the same region earlier in 2026.

Multiple individuals on the list of those who have vanished or died worked at or with NASA’s Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL), Los Alamos National Laboratory, or Air Force Research Laboratory projects involving asteroid defense, rocket engines, and classified aerospace systems.

No official connections have been publicly confirmed by law enforcement between the cases, yet the geographic clustering in New Mexico and California, combined with shared professional networks in nuclear and space tech, continues to fuel speculation.

California Dems Want To Protect Fraud and Target Journalism

SACRAMENTO, CA- “No Kings,” right? The rabid, radical left has engaged in a series of protests against policies of the Trump administration while claiming he is acting like a king, oblivious to the fact that, were Trump, in fact, a king, these unhinged moonbats would be rounded up and locked up...if they were lucky.

Instead, let's examine at least one proposed law in California that would significantly impact the First Amendment guarantees of freedom of speech and freedom of the press.

AB 2624, Privacy for immigration support services providers, was written by Rep. Mia Bonta, who just so happens to be the wife of California Attorney General Rob Bonta. Under the bill, it would "establish an address confidentiality program for a designated immigration support services provider, employee, or volunteer, as defined, who faces threats of violence or harassment from the public because of their affiliation with a designated immigration support services facility."

Such as a "Learning Center", such as independent journalist Nick Shirley found in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

In other words, the location of fraudulent day care centers, medicare support offices, hospice providers, etc., would be confidential.

It gets much worse and much more of an infringement on First Amendment protections. The bill continues:

"The bill would additionally prohibit a person, business, or association from soliciting, selling, or trading on the internet the personal information or image of a designated immigration support services provider, employee, or volunteer with the intent described above. The bill would also prohibit a person from posting on the internet, as described above, the personal information or image of a designated immigration support services provider, employee, or volunteer, or other individuals residing at the same home address."

California Assemblyman Carl DeMaio cut to the chase—he is calling AB2624 the "Stop Nick Shirley Act."

Google is Now Changing News Headlines – Without Permission.

Google is courting fresh controversy after starting to test a feature that rewrites article headlines without seeking permission or even notifying the publishers. The trial expands on earlier artificial intelligence (AI) tools, such as AI Overviews, which condense articles into short summaries. Media leaders voiced outrage at the complete lack of communication or approval, with one executive calling it “another overreach by Google taking liberties with content without permission.” They regard headlines as a core part of “editorial judgment” and essential to journalistic integrity. Changing them without disclosure could create serious problems, including a loss of reader confidence if the new versions turn out to be inaccurate or misleading.
