TRAIN WRECK: Biden, Schumer putting US-Israeli relations on a collision course Biden is cursing Netanyahu and demanding Israel not finish Hamas off in Rafah

The state of U.S.-Israeli relations is rapidly deteriorating.

And senior American Democrats are to blame.

Let me explain.

First, some context.

I'm in Dallas this week as part of a six-week media and speaking tour across the United States.

At churches and conferences, in meetings with pastors and other Evangelical leaders, and during various radio and TV interviews, I've been explaining the Hamas invasion of Oct. 7 and the horrific and painful war that we Israelis find ourselves in, and answering a wide range of questions.

During the "Chris Krok Show" on Sunday night on WBAP — the powerhouse Dallas radio station that's heard in 38 states — I was asked to comment on U.S. President Joe Biden and Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer openly and viciously attacking Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu in the midst of a hot war.

I didn't hold back.

iden is attacking Netanyahu behind closed doors with vulgar and obscene language, and White House aides are leaking those diatribes to the mainstream media.

Biden is also demanding that Netanyahu stop prosecuting the war against Hamas, telling the prime minister in a phone call that he will not support Israel invading the

city of Rafah, the southernmost city in the Gaza Strip and the last stronghold of Hamas leaders and terrorists.

If this weren't bad enough, Schumer is publicly attacking Netanyahu as the main "obstacle to peace" in Israel, saying that Netanyahu has "lost his way," and calling for immediate elections in Israel to get rid of the prime minister.

All of this is shameful, I said, and setting U.S.-Israeli relations on a collision course.

"The good news is that Israel is absolutely winning this war in terms of the military conflict," I told Chris.

"We have defeated about 20 of Hamas' 24 brigades. We have taken out most, but not quite all, of their terrorist leaders, and we've rescued or persuaded Hamas to give up and give back almost half of our hostages."

"But we are losing the battle for public opinion. And part of the reason is because of President Biden and Senate Majority Leader Schumer, who keep attacking the prime minister of Israel as being dangerous and irresponsible when we're fighting a bloodthirsty, genocidal enemy."

"That is not helpful," I noted. "It is not helpful for an American president and Senate majority leader to throw a democratically-elected leader under the bus during a war."

Indeed, such attacks on Israel's government could lead to a "train wreck" in relations between Jerusalem and Washington.

Canada has announced it will not export weapons to Israel anymore, drawing immediate condemnation from the Israeli government.

"It's regrettable that the Canadian government is taking a step that undermines Israel's right to self-defense against Hamas terrorists, who have committed terrible crimes against humanity and against innocent Israeli civilians, including the elderly, women, and children," Israeli Foreign Minister Israel Katz wrote on X.

"History will judge Canada's current action harshly," Katz added. "Israel will continue to fight until Hamas is destroyed and all hostages are returned home."

The minority left-leaning New Democrats Party (NDP) in Canada drafted the initial motion to stop all future arms exports to Israel, but the government embraced the measure of its minority partner, The Times of Israel reported.

The original motion included a cease-fire measure, recognition of a Palestinian state and a weapons sales suspension, but the government negotiated several key changes, including a change to only seek the "establishment of the State of Palestine as part of a negotiated two-state solution," the Toronto Star reported.

Every aspect of this story is bad, and each horrifying aspect is competing with the others for which can have the most negative consequences for the American people. More than 90% of Palestinians say no atrocities perpetrated on Oct. 7 Five months into Israel's war with Hamas, nearly three quarters of Palestinians in Gaza, Judea and Samaria support the Oct. 7 attack.

Ninety-three percent of Palestinians believe that Hamas did not commit atrocities during its mass invasion of southern Israel on Oct. 7, and 72% support the attack, according to recent polling conducted by the Palestinian Center for Policy and Survey Research (PCPSR).

The survey of 1,580 Palestinians in Gaza, Judea and Samaria was conducted between March 5 and 10 via in-person interviews. The margin of error was 3%.

Houthi Cruise Missile Hits Israel in Ominous First

Yemen's Houthis have claimed responsibility for a cruise missile launched from the Red Sea which landed near Eilat, in what marks the first time a projectile fired from the Iranian-backed group has struck Israel's territory.

The Iran-aligned militants have repeatedly launched drones and missiles at international commercial shipping in the region since November, in what they say is in solidarity with Palestinians against Israel's military assault in Gaza.

Previously, missiles and drones fired from Yemen had hit neighboring countries or were intercepted by air defenses.

Israel Defense Forces (IDF) said on Tuesday it had tracked a "suspicious aerial target" which it confirmed was a cruise missile, The Times of Israel reported. No damage or injuries were caused and Newsweek has contacted the IDF for comment.

Kushner notes value of Gaza 'waterfront property' if people would focus on livelihood

Ex-White House adviser and Trump's son-in-law laments Palestinian leaders' squandering 'decades of Western aid on tunnels and weapons rather than on improving lives'

Jared Kushner, Donald Trump's former White House adviser and his son-in-law, praised the "very valuable" potential of Gaza's "waterfront property," suggesting that Israel should remove civilians while it moving to "clean up" the area.

"Gaza's waterfront property, it could be very valuable, if people would focus on building up livelihoods," Kushner said in an interview dated Feb. 15, posted earlier this month on the YouTube channel of the Middle East Initiative, a program of Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government, and reported first on Tuesday by The Guardian.

"If you think about all the money that's gone into this tunnel network and into all the munitions, if that would have gone into education or innovation, what could have been done?"

Gaza's Pier Could Be an International Refugee Pandora's Box

U.S. ships will soon head to the Gaza coast to build a floating pier to provide Gazans with humanitarian aid. While President Joe Biden trumpets the pier's potential to facilitate emergency assistance, it is unclear if he has thought through its complexities, and especially the legal implications for building such a structure.

As troops deploy from Newport News, Virginia, shocked at the short notice, the Pentagon is under the clock to develop a detailed plan before they arrive in the Eastern Mediterranean. Very roughly, the Pentagon seeks to construct a large floating dock adjacent to their ships. From there, transfer vessels will carry aid to a floating pier with a two-lane causeway stretching 1800 feet to Gaza's coast. Biden says there will be no U.S. boots on the ground in Gaza, just on the pier. The biggest analogy to the Biden plan was a Joint Logistics Over-the-Shore operation to provide emergency food aid after the 2010 Haiti earthquake given that country's civil unrest or to a lesser extent Hurricane Mitch in Honduras in 1998.

The circumstances in Gaza, however, are different. Gaza is an active war zone with Hamas embedded within the civilian population and stealing aid that comes through. This poses a security problem: Could civilians stampede the pier to either seek supplies or find safety? Does the United States have a plan to keep Hamas from diverting aid? Will there be an inspection regime for international assistance utilizing the pier given Hamas' record of diverting aid to its military, tunnel, and terror infrastructure?

Under maritime law, U.S. naval ships are U.S. territory, even while they are in another nation's territorial waters. Unlike in Haiti where a pier already existed and the Navy simply repaired it and then docked its ships, this pier in Gaza's waters, whether built by the U.S. armed forces or independent contractors, could be considered U.S. property, and therefore, U.S. territory. This raises a number of follow-on legal questions that the Biden administration has yet to answer:

First, if the U.S. constructs a floating dock that can be attached to its ships, is that extension also considered U.S. territory?

Second, if the U.S. constructs a pier that is movable or removable, to whom does that structure belong? If it is anchored to Gaza's beach, does it become part of Gaza's territory or does it remain U.S. property?

Third, if the pier is, indeed, U.S. property as it is removable and if it is U.S. territory, would anyone entering it be able to claim asylum or refugee status in the United States?

Illegal migrant from Lebanon caught at border admitted he's a Hezbollah terrorist hoping 'to make a bomb' — and was headed for NY

The Russian military police have set up an additional checkpoint in the Golan Heights area in order to monitor the disengagement line separating Israeli and Syrian forces, an official said Thursday.

Military police will monitor the situation on the Bravo disengagement line, Rear Adm. Vadim Kulit, deputy chief of the Russian Center for Reconciliation of the Opposing Parties in Syria, said at a press briefing in Damascus.

Russia has been warning since the outbreak of the Israel-Hamas war in the Gaza Strip last October that the conflict may spread further in the region, including to countries that have territorial disputes with Israel.
