'Satan loves you and respects who you are,' Target pride partner's social media post reads

Target has found itself in hot water again over its gay pride collection, this time because of its partnership with a controversial designer.

The major retailer partnered with U.K.-based brand Abprallen to sell merchandise with pro-LGBTQ messages to celebrate Pride month. A search on Target's website finds some of the items.

Abprallen also sells merchandise with aggressive messages attacking critics. Pins with the phrases "heteronormativity is a plague" and "burn down the cis-tem" are featured on the website along with one that says "homophobe headrest" with an image of a guillotine.

Carnell, the transgender designer behind the brand, explained in an Instagram post that Satan represents "passion, pride and liberty" and "loves all LGBT+ people."

"Satanists don't actually believe in Satan, he is merely used as a symbol of passion, pride, and liberty. He means to you what you need him to mean. So for me, Satan is hope, compassion, equality, and love. So, naturally, Satan respects pronouns. He loves all LGBT+ people. I went with a variation of Baphomet for this design, a deity who themselves is a mixture of genders, beings, ideas, and existences. They reject binary stereotypes and expectations. Perfect," he said.

Target donated \$2.1 mil to group that suggests hiding gender transitions from parents  
The news of Target's years-long partnership with GLSEN comes amid ongoing market backlash over the retail giant's 2020 Pride line, which includes many products geared towards children and babies.

The Minneapolis-based Target Corporation has donated more than \$2 million to an organization that encourages school districts to conceal students' gender transitions from parents.

Target has donated at least \$2.1 million to the Gay, Lesbian, and Straight Education Network (GLSEN), Fox News first reported. Target says on its website that it has partnered with GLSEN for 10 years to support "its mission to create affirming, accessible and antiracist spaces for LGBTQIA+ students."

GLSEN published a model policy in October 2020 that recommends school districts adopt the following language: "Staff or educators shall not disclose any information that may reveal a student's gender identity to others, including parents or guardians and other staff, unless the student has authorized such disclosure, the information is contained in school records requested by a parent or guardian, or there is another compelling need. This disclosure must be discussed with the student, prior to any action."

Withholding this information from parents "may represent a matter of safety and wellbeing at home" for some students, the model policy says.

California lawmakers to honor anti-Catholic Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence member, despite Dodgers backlash

California legislature's LGBTQ Caucus to honor group at center of Los Angeles Dodgers controversy

The California State Legislature's LGBTQ Caucus is poised to honor a member of the Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence, the controversial group at the center of a backlash engulfing the Los Angeles Dodgers.

The Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence, who identify as a group of "queer and trans nuns," are known for mocking Christian beliefs, including holding an annual "Foxy Mary" and "Hunky Jesus" contest, pole dancing on crosses, and using the saying, "Go forth and sin some more!"

Michael Williams, a member of the group known as "Sister Roma" who runs a podcast covering pornographic movies and LGBTQ issues, is on the honoree list for the California Senate's upcoming Pride recognition night.

"For more than three decades, Sister Roma has been one of the most outspoken and globally recognized members of San Francisco's Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence," the LGBTQ Caucus' announcement said.

"Honoring the Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence, a group whose sole mission is to sexualize nuns and mock Jesus, reveals the true depth of hatred California's elected officials have for the millions of Catholics residing in the state," Mark Trammell, the executive director of the Center for American Liberty, told Fox News Digital.

The Dodgers recently came under fire after announcing their plan to honor the L.A.-based branch of the Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence with the "Community Hero Award" before their June 16 game.

After Sen. Marco Rubio, R-Fla., and religious groups like CatholicVote voiced their concern over the award, the team announced it would no longer be honoring the group at the Pride event "given the strong feelings of people who have been offended by the sisters' inclusion in our evening."

Just days after their decision to uninvite the group, the Dodgers apologized to the Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence and reinvited them to the event, an announcement that garnered even more backlash from the religious community and players within the baseball league.

Blinken says US to consider visa restrictions over Ugandan anti-gay law

U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken on Monday said his government would consider visa restrictions against Ugandan officials and others for the abuse of human rights following the implementation of one of the world's toughest anti-gay laws.

Blinken said he has instructed the State Department to update travel guidance to U.S. citizens and businesses over travel to Uganda.

The measures follow President Joe Biden's condemnation of the Ugandan legislation.

Biden said the United States may impose sanctions and would evaluate the implications of the law "on all aspects of U.S. engagement with Uganda."

Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni on Monday signed the anti-LGBTQ laws, which includes the death penalty for "aggravated homosexuality," drawing Western condemnation and raising the risk of sanctions by aid donors.

Anti-Christian vandals repeatedly desecrate college's historic monument commemorating missionaries: 'Hail Satan.'

A Christian monument at a private liberal arts college in Massachusetts has been repeatedly defaced by vandals this past month, the College Fix reported.

Williams College's Haystack Monument was spray-painted with satanic phrases written in red graffiti.

The first attack occurred in mid-May, according to a press release from the college. Vandals desecrated the over 150-year-old monument with phrases including "Pagan Rule," "Blood," "Ouch," "Hail Satan," and an obscenity.

"Given that the Monument memorializes the Christian missionary movement, some people may experience these incidents as attacks on your religion or you personally. You belong here, and I will work for your and everyone's right to a safe community," the president wrote.

Williams College's Haystack Monument is a 12-foot marble pillar that was erected in 1867 to commemorate five former students who became "Christian missionaries while taking shelter during a storm under a haystack" and went on to found an American missionary movement.

Biden Grant Recipient: Christian Broadcasting Path To White Supremism

The Biden administration approved tens of thousands of dollars in grants to a program that once taught watching the Christian Broadcasting Network (CBN) eased conservatives onto the path to become a neo-Nazi, a new report has found.

The University of Dayton applied for a grant from the Targeted Violence and Terrorism Prevention Grant Program (TVTP), administered by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), to combat viewpoints it considers extreme. In the application packet, the Catholic-affiliated university included a link to a webinar title "Extremism, Rhetoric, and Democratic Precarity," according to a new report.

That presentation featured a "Pyramid of Far-Right Radicalization," which shows conservatives being led into white racialist violence or radicalism by interacting with CBN or the GOP, according to documents uncovered by the Media Research Center.

The first layer of the pyramid shows CBN, the Heritage Foundation, the Tea Party, the John Birch Society, and the Republican National Committee. The next step toward embracing anti-Semitism includes clicking on Jewish conservative Dennis Prager's PragerU, Turning Point USA, or supporting the Make America Great Again movement, said the graphic designed by University of Cincinnati researcher Michael Loadenthal.

The next two rungs of the "far-Right" pyramid consist of white nationalist and "race realist" groups that span from ideologically or intellectually oriented websites -- including American Renaissance, Richard Spencer's National Policy Institute, and the neo-Nazi website Daily Stormer -- to extremist "accelerationist" groups seeking to foment chaos and terror.

'The Chosen' Faces Boycott Calls After Pride Flag Spotted on Set

The Chosen has become the latest target of boycott calls from a faction of conservatives after an LGBTQ+ Pride flag was spotted on the Christian historical drama's set.

Distributed internationally by Lionsgate Television, The Chosen is the first multi-series show that traces the life, death and resurrection of Jesus of Nazareth. Some \$45 million—mostly through crowdfunding—was spent on the first two seasons of the production. A third season premiered in December and concluded in February.

While The Chosen has garnered largely positive reviews, it is now facing criticism and boycott calls for the presence of an LGBTQ+ Pride flag that was spotted in behind-the-scenes footage of the show's upcoming fourth season.
