Is Donald Trump's Sweeping Gaza Peace Plan Really Viable?

Many doubts prevail, but the deal is "political gold" for Benjamin Netanyahu either way.

Even for a man prone to hyperbole, President Donald Trump soared into the stratosphere this week by heralding the announcement of his new peace plan for the Middle East as "potentially one of the great days ever in civilization." The twenty-point plan is ambitiously, if vaguely, designed to end the nearly two-year war in Gaza; bring home all the hostages, both dead and alive; create a committee to govern the territory; demilitarize Hamas; and eventually eliminate "any danger posed in the region." It calls for Israeli troops to withdraw from Gaza, in phases, but allows them to keep an undefined security perimeter until there is no "resurgent terror threat." "This is eternity," Trump said, on Monday, while rambling for half an hour from a lectern in the East Room of the White House. "This is for forever."

Trump appointing himself to head this peace board [with the former British Prime Minister Tony] Blair as his underling would be the stuff of fine comedy,” Daniel Levy, a former Israeli negotiator who now leads the U.S./Middle East Project, told me.

Swiss voters narrowly approve plan for electronic ID cards

Swiss voters have narrowly approved a plan to introduce voluntary electronic identity cards.

With all votes counted, 50.4% of those who voted said yes to the proposal, while 49.6% rejected it.

The closeness of the ballot is a surprise. Opinion polls had suggested up to 60% backed digital IDs, which also had the approval of the Swiss government, and both houses of parliament.

It was Switzerland's second vote on digital IDs. An earlier proposal was rejected in 2021, amid concerns the data would be held centrally, and controlled largely by private providers.

2 killed in Yom Kippur attack at UK synagogue; suspect shot by police; bomb disposal team on scene

Two people have died in an attack at a synagogue in Manchester in northern England and a third person suspected to be the offender who was shot by police is also believed to have died, a police statement says.

Police say they cannot confirm if the suspect is dead “due to safety issues surround suspicious items on his person.”

A bomb disposal unit has been called and is now at the scene.

Three more people have been seriously injured in the attack, police say.

The attack took place on Yom Kippur, the Jewish Day of Atonement and the holiest day of the Jewish calendar.

Minister paves way for nationwide facial recognition rollout

A minister has paved the way for a nationwide rollout of live facial recognition (LFR) cameras to catch criminals.

Sarah Jones, the policing minister, said the Government was planning to publish national guidance that would tell police forces where, when and how to use the technology more widely.

The Home Office has committed funding to deploy facial recognition cameras in seven police forces: Greater Manchester, West Yorkshire, Bedfordshire, Surrey, Sussex, Thames Valley, and Hampshire.

President Donald Trump on Tuesday proposed using American cities, including Chicago, as training grounds for the armed forces and spoke of needing the U.S. military to combat what he called the "invasion from within."

He was joined by Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth, who declared an end to "woke" culture and announced new directives for troops that include "gender-neutral" or "male-level" standards for physical fitness.

A timeline of police activity at Portland ICE Facility since protests began in June

The Oregon Military Department has confirmed that National Guard members could be ready for their mission in Portland as early as this weekend.

This comes after President Donald Trump authorized 200 National Guard members to protect “war-ravaged Portland and other ICE facilities under attack.”

Protesters began a sustained action at the ICE Facility in Southwest Portland in early June after several asylum seekers were arrested outside immigration court in Portland.

Pete Hegseth's speech wasn't just insulting to the military. It was radical. Hegseth disparaged some generals as "fat." But more concerning was what he wants them to do for the president.

Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth summoned more than 800 military leaders from all over the world to a base in Quantico, Virginia, on Tuesday morning — only to dress them down. Pacing back and forth against the backdrop of a giant American flag in the highly unusual (and televised) convening of military brass, Hegseth declared it “completely unacceptable to see fat generals and admirals” in the military. Even though Hegseth’s main qualification for Trump’s Cabinet seems to have been his time working for Fox News, he told the military leaders assembled before him that many of them hadn’t earned their promotions, but were only advanced because of their race or sex.
