Trump warns the US will seize key Iranian oil export hub Kharg Island

He also threatened to take control of Iran's oil and gas markets, after Tehran and the US traded strikes overnight.

Trump's threat on key Iranian island: President Donald Trump warned that the US will hit Iran "VERY HARD TONIGHT" and vowed to take Kharg Island, which handles roughly 90% of Iran's crude exports. Plans to capture the island have been drawn up for months but continuously shelved because it was considered too risky, sources say.

- Escalation in hostilities: Iran's Revolutionary Guards said they targeted US bases in the region overnight for a second consecutive day, following US strikes across Iran. In response to the strikes, Iran said the Strait of Hormuz was closed — a claim the US military rejected. A senior Iranian official told CNN in Tehran that Iran would "respond more severely" to any future attacks.
- Talks under pressure: A Qatari delegation left Tehran after negotiations with Iranian officials, a diplomatic source said. The talks, conducted in coordination with the US, lasted into the early hours of Thursday morning local time, as the US was striking Iran.

Turkey's Ottoman Dreams And Ezekiel's Warning

The war of words between Turkey and Israel is becoming increasingly difficult to ignore. What was once a tense diplomatic relationship has evolved into something far more confrontational, with Turkish leaders openly speaking about Jerusalem, threatening Israel, and positioning themselves as champions of the Islamic world against the Jewish state.

This week, the rhetoric reached another alarming level.

Turkey's Interior Minister Mustafa Çiftçi openly declared his hope that one day Turkey would witness the "liberation of Jerusalem" just as it had supposedly witnessed the "liberation" of Damascus, Aleppo, and Karabakh. He even expressed a desire to become governor of Jerusalem for a day, declaring that lands once controlled by the Ottoman Empire would one day return to Turkish sovereignty.

For Israelis, these comments were not viewed as harmless political theater. They were interpreted as a direct challenge to Israel's sovereignty and a revival of old Ottoman ambitions.

Israel's response was swift and sharp.

Foreign Minister Gideon Sa'ar reminded Turkey that "the corrupt Ottoman Empire is gone. Forever."

This week Erdoğan also warned that Israeli military actions in Syria and Lebanon threaten Turkey itself. He declared that Turkey's security extends beyond its own borders into Aleppo, Damascus, and Beirut. He further warned that Turkey would respond forcefully if Turkish or Turkish-Cypriot interests were threatened.

Such statements reveal a growing willingness by Ankara to project military and political influence far beyond its borders.

At the same time, Israel increasingly views Turkey's support for Hamas and its close relationship with Islamist movements across the region as a direct threat.

As Spy Law Nears Expiration, Lawmakers Mull Short-Term Renewal

Trump's choice of Bill Pulte as acting director of national intelligence has sparked objections from Senate Democrats.

President Donald Trump's pick for a key intelligence post has left Democrats and Republicans at odds over a spy law set to lapse on June 12.

As the clock ticks down, lawmakers are contemplating Trump's latest proposal: another short-term extension of the authority while the president searches for a permanent nominee other than his chosen acting director of national intelligence, Bill Pulte.

Section 702 of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA) allows the government to spy on foreign targets outside the United States.

At the Paris Cyber Summit, Allies Test a ‘Transatlantic Reset’ With One Eye on China
Participants told The Epoch Times that whatever divides Europe and the United States today matters less than the threats giving them a reason to stay together.

The eighth Paris Cyber Summit convened on June 2 and 3 at the Maison de la Chimie under the theme “The Transatlantic Reset,” focusing on how the United States and Europe can rebuild a shared digital agenda after years of regulatory friction and geopolitical shock.

The exchanges addressed a key question: how allies should assess the threats posed by China and Russia.

Sébastien Garnault, the summit’s founder, opened the gathering with a call for candid conversations among partners. He said he wanted the two days to settle “how we assess the threats, and how we are answering to the threats as allies.”

The invitation-only forum drew senior officials, regulators, and industry leaders from both sides of the Atlantic, among them figures from the U.S. Department of War, the FBI, NATO, the European Commission, France, Ukraine, Google, and CrowdStrike.

Anthropic opens most powerful AI model to public with safeguards

Anthropic, maker of the Claude artificial intelligence (AI) models, on Tuesday made the most powerful version of its technology available to the general public while restricting it from use in sensitive areas.

Dubbed Fable 5, the model is the first from the Mythos class — Anthropic’s most advanced lineup of AI technology, unveiled in April but restricted over cybersecurity concerns — to be made widely available.

Anthropic says Fable 5 is exceptionally good at writing and debugging software code, answering complex research questions and analyzing images.

In parallel, Anthropic is offering an unrestricted version, Claude Mythos 5, to companies and organizations that already have access to this model family — including cybersecurity partners enrolled in its Project Glasswing program.

That select group was expanded in early June to around 200 organizations in more than 15 countries and is expected to grow further.

Anthropic has restricted access to Mythos on cybersecurity grounds, given what the company calls its ability to quickly identify vulnerabilities in critical infrastructure, such as banking, power grids, and software.

When Project Glasswing launched, some critics accused Anthropic of overhyping the threat so as to generate attention.

First AI-designed ‘universal vaccine’ tested in humans: UK researchers

A vaccine targeting a broad range of viruses that was designed using artificial intelligence had a “modest” effect on immune systems in a small, early trial, according to a new study.

The trial marks the first time a vaccine whose active ingredient was entirely designed by AI has been tested in humans, researchers at the University of Cambridge in the UK said on Friday.

The experimental jab is intended to be a “universal vaccine” which protects people against a range of viruses that have previously sparked deadly outbreaks including SARS, MERS and Covid-19.

The researchers expressed hopes that this type of vaccine could one day help fend off future pandemics.

“We’ve converted vaccine development from being reactive to being future proof,” Cambridge researcher and study co-author Jonathan Heeney said in a statement.

Belfast in peril as homes targeted by protesters pledging to ‘get the foreigners out’ after bus torched

Tensions boiled over in Belfast on Tuesday night as furious crowds torched vehicles, homes, and a public bus in response to a brutal knife attack the previous evening.

The unrest unfolded after a 30-year-old Sudanese man, who had been granted indefinite leave to remain in the UK, was charged with attempted murder.

Police described the assault, which occurred around 10:30 p.m. Monday on Kinnaird Avenue in north Belfast, as involving repeated stabbings to the victim’s

face, neck, and back with a kitchen knife. Graphic footage circulating online showed bystanders intervening to subdue the suspect, including one using a hurling stick.

A CHRISTIAN IS KILLED EVERY 2 HOURS IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA

It's difficult to overstate the size of the problem facing Christians in Nigeria. According to the latest research from Open Doors' 2026 World Watch List (conducted from Oct. 1, 2024-September 30, 2025), around 70% of Christians killed for their faith last year were in Nigeria.

But it's also not just Nigeria. Sub-Saharan Africa is the most violent region in the world for Christians. Fourteen of the 50 countries on the 2026 World Watch List are in sub-Saharan Africa, and out of a total of 4,849 total faith-related deaths worldwide, 4,491 deaths took place in sub-Saharan Africa—a staggering 93% of the global number.

To put it another way: Every 1.95 hours on average, a Christian in sub-Saharan Africa is killed for their faith.

US attorney predicts ‘people will be charged’ over California voter rolls

Bill Essayli, the first assistant U.S. attorney for the Central District of California, on Monday said it is likely “people will be charged” over alleged voter fraud in California.

“I expect people will be charged. But we need a wide-scale audit of the California voter roll, which is what Harmeet and I have been trying to do for the last year,” Essayli said, referring to Assistant Attorney General for the Civil Rights Division Harmeet Dhillon, during an appearance on “The Glenn Beck Program.”

Republican lawmakers have cast doubt on the L.A. mayoral race as GOP candidate Spencer Pratt did not advance to a runoff despite being in second place when the polls closed on June 2.

Knesset advances quasi-constitutional Basic Law bill effectively equating Torah study with IDF service

The Knesset votes 56-43 to advance a controversial Basic Law declaring Torah study a foundational value of the State of Israel, and effectively equating the study of Torah with military service.

Sponsored by ultra-Orthodox United Torah Judaism lawmakers MKs Moshe Gafni and Yaakov Asher, and backed by the ultra-Orthodox Shas party, the quasi-constitutional measure seeks to enshrine Torah study as a foundational value of the State of Israel and recognize long-term Torah study as service to the state and the Jewish people.
