Netanyahu said to have asked Trump to hold off on Iran strike

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu asked US President Donald Trump over the past day to delay potential plans for an American strike on Iran, a senior US official tells The New York Times.

According to the report, Trump and Netanyahu spoke yesterday about the issue, on the same day that Trump announced he had heard “on good authority” that the killing of protesters in Iran had stopped — appearing to back away from his recent threats to attack.

Following The New York Times report, Channel 12 reports that after a series of overnight consultations at the Kirya military headquarters, Israel informed the US that while it supports any US decision, it is not currently pushing for a strike.

The Hebrew network adds that a US attack remains on the table as Washington continues to assess the situation, citing five sources involved in or familiar with White House discussions on the matter.

Jerusalem and Washington are holding daily consultations, the report continues, adding that US Secretary of State Marco Rubio also spoke with Netanyahu yesterday for reportedly the third conversation within six days.

While military options remain on the table for Trump, the current pause is also being viewed as an opening for diplomacy, the network continues, citing a US official as saying that the regime will collapse unless Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei agrees to speak directly with Trump.

Iran protests abate after deadly crackdown, residents and rights group say

Iran's deadly crackdown appears to have broadly quelled protests for now, according to a rights group and residents, as state media reported more arrests on Friday in the shadow of repeated U.S. threats to intervene if the killing continues. The prospect of a U.S. attack has retreated since Wednesday, when President Donald Trump said he'd been told killings in Iran were easing, but more U.S. military assets were expected to arrive in the region, showing the continued tensions.

U.S. allies, including Saudi Arabia and Qatar, conducted intense diplomacy with Washington this week to prevent a U.S. strike, warning of repercussions for the wider region that would ultimately impact the United States, a Gulf official said. Israel's intelligence chief David Barnea was also in the U.S. on Friday for talks on Iran, according to a source familiar with the matter, and an Israeli military official said the country's forces were on "peak readiness".

The White House said on Thursday that Trump and his team have warned Tehran there would be "grave consequences" if there was further bloodshed and added that the president was keeping "all of his options on the table".

No Plan to Hang Protesters, Iranian Foreign Minister Says

Trump earlier said that executions by the regime won't take place.

Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi said on Jan. 14 that there is no plan for the regime to hang people, when asked about the protests across the Islamic Republic.

When asked directly about potential executions during an interview on Fox News, Araghchi said hanging is out of the question.

"I can tell you, I am confident about that. There is no plan for hanging at all," he said. "This is another piece of the misinformation campaign ... to provoke President Trump and drag him into this question that could have disastrous consequences."

Witkoff indicates US prefers to resolve Iran tensions with diplomacy, not military action

US envoy says agreement with Islamic Republic would address nuclear enrichment, ballistic missiles, Iran's existing stockpile of enriched material, and its proxies

US special envoy Steve Witkoff suggested on Thursday that the Trump administration prefers a diplomatic resolution, rather than a military one, to the ongoing tensions with Iran, sparked by the regime's deadly violence against protesters.

Asked in an onstage interview at the Israeli-American Council conference in Florida if he thinks a US military strike against Iran is likely, Witkoff responded, "I hope there's a diplomatic resolution. I really do."

The US envoy said a diplomatic agreement with Iran would address four issues: "(1) nuclear enrichment, (2) missiles — they have to cut back on their inventory; (3) the actual [nuclear] material that they have, which is roughly 2000 kilograms enriched anywhere between 3.67 percent and 60%; and (4) the proxies.

US launches phase two of Gaza peace plan with new technocratic government

US envoy Steve Witkoff has announced the start of phase two of President Donald Trump's plan to end the war in Gaza, with a technocratic Palestinian government established in the territory.

Under phase one, Hamas and Israel agreed a ceasefire in October, as well as a hostage-prisoner exchange, a partial Israeli withdrawal, and an aid surge.

Witkoff said phase two would also see the reconstruction and full demilitarisation of Gaza, including the disarmament of Hamas and other Palestinian groups.

"The US expects Hamas to comply fully with its obligations," he warned, noting these include the return of the body of the last dead Israeli hostage. "Failure to do so will bring serious consequences."

Palestinian technocrats invited to join transitional Gaza governing committee — sources

Former deputy PA minister to head panel; Gaza Chamber of Commerce head, who will also be a member, tells *Tol* he is 'eager to start work to alleviate suffering of Gazans'

Roughly a dozen Palestinians received official invitations on Tuesday to serve on the technocratic committee slated to manage Gaza's daily affairs in place of Hamas, an Arab diplomat and a Palestinian official told *The Times of Israel*.

The letters were signed by the Board of Peace's designated high representative, Nikolay Mladenov, two of the technocrats who received the letters said.

Mladenov, a Bulgarian diplomat who previously served as the UN special envoy to the Middle East, will be tasked with directly overseeing the technocratic committee on behalf of the Board of Peace. He held meetings last week with senior officials in Israel and the Palestinian Authority in preparation for the transition to phase two of US President Donald Trump's peace plan for the Gaza Strip, which could be announced as early as Wednesday, the Arab diplomat said.

European nations send additional troops to Greenland as US annexation threats escalate

Several European NATO countries are deploying small numbers of military personnel to Greenland to participate in joint exercises with Denmark as US President Donald Trump ramps up his threats to forcibly annex the Arctic island.

Trump's declarations have thrown Europe's decades-old, US-led security alliance into crisis, raising the prospect of NATO's largest and most powerful member annexing the territory of another.

Denmark, which is responsible for Greenland's defense, has warned an attack on Greenland would all but end NATO, and announced on Wednesday that it was expanding its military presence "in close cooperation with NATO allies."

Germany, Sweden, France, Norway, the Netherlands and Finland have all since confirmed they are sending military personnel to Greenland this week.

Canada and France have also said they plan to open consulates in Nuuk, Greenland's capital, in the coming weeks.

French President Emmanuel Macron said Thursday that a French military team was "already on the ground" and would be reinforced in the coming days with "air, sea and land components." Finland's defense ministry confirmed it would send two military liaison officers to the territory.

It is not unusual for NATO countries to send troops to train in other NATO countries, and there has been a years-long push by allies, including the US, to ramp up joint exercises in the Arctic Circle. The US has about 150 troops stationed at its Pituffik Space Base in northwestern Greenland.

But both the timing and symbolism of the latest announcements by European nations are a significant show of solidarity at a time of unprecedented tension within NATO.

NATO considering deploying fighter jets over Greenland while Russia condemns Trump's rhetoric

A chilling new chapter in global tension is unfolding above the frozen wastes of the Arctic, where the specter of military confrontation now threatens one of the world's most remote frontiers.

Joint Interagency Task Force Announces First Replicator 2 Purchase to Counter Homeland Drone Threats

Joint Interagency Task Force 401 announced Jan. 11 its first acquisition under the Replicator 2 initiative, awarding a contract for two advanced DroneHunter F700 systems, which are expected to be delivered by April.

This acquisition provides the task force with enhanced capabilities to counter the growing threat posed by small unmanned aerial systems. It also marks a significant step in the War Department's strategy to rapidly field counter-unmanned aerial systems to protect military installations and critical infrastructure across the United States.

"We're designed to move at the speed of relevance, cutting through red tape, consolidating resources, and engaging venture capitalists, tech startups, and nontraditional defense firms as critical partners," said Army Brig. Gen. Matt Ross, JIATF 401 director.

"We have just one measure of effectiveness: to deliver state-of-the-art counter-UAS capabilities to our warfighters both at home and abroad. This purchase of the DroneHunter system is a key first step in accomplishing our Replicator 2 mission," Ross added.

Replicator 2: A New Approach to Counter-UAS

The Replicator initiative, first announced in August 2023, is a War Department effort to accelerate the delivery of innovative capabilities to the warfighter at speed and scale.

While the first phase, Replicator 1, was focused on deploying thousands of autonomous systems across multiple domains, Replicator 2 is specifically aimed at countering the threat posed by small UAS.

US used powerful mystery weapon that brought Venezuelan soldiers to their knees during Maduro raid

In a shocking development following the recent U.S. military operation in Caracas, new details have emerged regarding the specialized technology used to neutralize the presidential compound.

According to a report from the New York Post, witnesses on the ground describe the use of a “powerful sonic weapon” that left guards and residents incapacitated during the high-stakes raid to capture Nicolás Maduro.

The weapon, reportedly a Long Range Acoustic Device (LRAD) or a similar high-intensity sonic transmitter, was used to create a “wall of sound” that disoriented those inside the fortified Miraflores Palace.

Witness accounts gathered by the New York Post suggest that the device caused immediate physical distress to anyone in its path. One witness, a former member of the palace security detail, described the experience as an “unbearable pressure that felt like your head was going to explode,” adding that “it wasn’t just loud; it was a physical force that made it impossible to stand or even think.”

Grocery Chain Wegmans Defends Collection of Biometric Data in Some Stores

The New York-based chain said facial recognition technology is deployed in only a small number of higher-risk stores and is not used to track ordinary shoppers.

Wegmans Food Markets said on Jan. 7 that it uses facial recognition technology in a limited number of higher-risk stores to deter misconduct, responding to growing scrutiny from the public and demands from New York lawmakers for greater transparency about biometric surveillance in grocery stores.

The Rochester, New York-based grocery chain said in a statement that the facial recognition technology is deployed only in “a small fraction” of its locations that have higher security risks and is used only to identify individuals previously flagged for misconduct, not to track or profile ordinary shoppers.

“At Wegmans, the safety of our customers and employees is a top priority,” the company said in the statement. “Like many retailers, we use cameras to help identify individuals who pose a risk to our people, customers, or operation.”

Nvidia to invest \$1B in AI drug laboratory with Eli Lilly

Nvidia is building a facility in Silicon Valley to enhance drug discovery through AI. This joint investment aims to expedite lab processes that currently depend on human researchers.

Nvidia sees potential in healthcare, where AI can automate experiments. Kimberly Powell, Nvidia’s VP, stated, “Humans are the primary constraint on the speed of labs.”

The lab will train AI engineers in lab operations and refine AI software for drug development. Nvidia is also expanding its AI models for healthcare and collaborating with Thermo Fisher to automate lab equipment.

Japanese scientists' 'living skin' implant glows to warn of illness

A high-tech "living skin" implant glows green to warn when illness is about to strike.

The next generation of wearable health devices has been successfully trialled in mice by scientists in Japan.

They explained that the state of the art implant monitors internal biomarkers - proteins that indicate inflammation, stress, or disease.

The process usually relies on blood sampling or externally attached sensors that operate only for limited durations.

In the new approach the skin lights up to signal health changes

Wearable health devices - such as smartwatches - have become commonplace, enabling continuous monitoring of physiological signals at the skin's surface.

Now a Japanese research team has developed a "biohybrid" approach that works inside the body - transforming engineered skin to a visible indicator of internal biological states.

The group, led by scientists from Tokyo City University and the University of Tokyo working with RIKEN and Canon Medical Systems engineers, created the living sensor display.
