No, the human-robot singularity isn't here. But we must take action to govern AI

Moltbook, a social media site for AI agents, is nothing new. Still, the marriage of big tech and politics demands we take a stand

In a recent trip to the San Francisco Bay Area, I was shocked by the billboards that lined the freeway outside of the airport. "The singularity is here," proclaimed one. "Humanity had a good run," said another. It seemed like every other sign along the road was plastered with claims from tech firms making outrageous claims about artificial intelligence. The ads, of course, were rife with hype and ragebait. But the claims they contain aren't occurring in a vacuum. The OpenAI CEO, Sam Altman, recently said: "We basically have built AGI, or very close to it," before confusingly qualifying his statement as "spiritual". Elon Musk has gone even further, claiming: "We have entered the singularity."

Enter Moltbook, the social media site built for AI agents. A place where bots can talk to other bots, in other words. A spate of doom-laden news articles and op-eds followed its launch. The authors fretted about the fact that the bots were talking about religion, claiming to have secretly spent their human builders' money, and even plotting the overthrow of humanity. Many pieces contained suggestions eerily like those on the billboards in San Francisco: that machines are now not only as smart as humans (a theory known as artificial general intelligence) but that they are moving beyond us (a sci-fi concept known as the singularity).

Based upon my years of research on bots, AI and computational propaganda, I can tell you two things with near certainty. First, Moltbook is nothing new. Humans have built bots that can talk to one another – and to humans – for decades. They’ve been designed to make outlandish, even frightening, claims throughout this time. Second, the singularity is not here. Nor is AGI. According to most researchers, neither is remotely close. AI’s advancement is limited by a number of very tangible factors: mathematics, data access and business costs among them. Claims that AGI or the singularity have arrived are not grounded in empirical research or science.

But as tech companies breathlessly promote their AI capabilities another thing is also clear: big tech is now far from being the countervailing force it was during the first Trump administration. The overblown claims emanating from Silicon Valley about AI have become intertwined with the nationalism of the US government as the two work together in a bid to “win” the AI race. Meanwhile, ICE is paying Palantir \$30m to provide AI-enabled software that may be used for government surveillance. Musk and other tech executives continue to champion far-right causes. Google and Apple also removed apps people were using to track ICE from their digital storefronts after political pressure.

Bill Gates cancels speech at India AI summit: Gates Foundation

Bill Gates has cancelled his speech that was scheduled for Thursday at a major AI summit in India, the Gates Foundation said, after the Microsoft founder was named in the Epstein files.

“After careful consideration, and to ensure the focus remains on the AI Summit’s key priorities, Mr. Gates will not be delivering his keynote address,” the foundation said in a statement.

“The Gates Foundation remains fully committed to our work in India to advance our shared health and development goals,” it said.

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and tech CEOs will speak about the opportunities and threats posed by artificial intelligence at the AI Impact Summit in New Delhi on Thursday.

The Gates Foundation said the president of its Africa and India offices would speak instead.

Gates this month said he regrets “every minute” he spent with Jeffrey Epstein, as his former wife Melinda said he still had questions to answer over his relationship with the late convicted sexual offender.

The latest tranche of documents released by the US Justice Department contained emails between many prominent figures and Epstein — often revealing warm friendships, illicit financial dealings and private photos.

In a draft email among the documents, Epstein alleged Gates engaged in extramarital affairs.

## Nancy Guthrie Case Exposes How Technology Tracks Our Every Move

When Nancy Guthrie vanished from her home in Tucson, the initial reaction was the same familiar dread that accompanies every missing-person case: fear, confusion, and a race against time. But what unfolded next was not familiar at all. This investigation did not hinge on eyewitnesses or lucky breaks. It became something far more unsettling -- a demonstration of how modern life has quietly transformed into a vast forensic web. And now, with investigators reportedly awaiting DNA results from a glove discovered near the scene, the case may soon prove that in 2026, technology doesn't just assist detectives. It is the detective.

Nancy Guthrie, mother of journalist Savannah Guthrie, disappeared without signs of forced entry or struggle. In past decades, that would have meant weeks of door-to-door interviews and little else. Today, investigators began somewhere entirely different: data. As one national television report from Fox News observed, modern digital evidence from phones, cameras, and networks can reconstruct movements

with astonishing precision. In this case, that digital reconstruction became the backbone of the investigation.

The most revealing tool reportedly used early on was a device many Americans had never heard of until now: Cellebrite. This suitcase-sized system, known as a Universal Forensic Extraction Device, can extract data from phones, SIM cards, and apps -- even if the information has been deleted or the phone is locked. Investigators use it to recover texts, location logs, app histories, and hidden system data.

Perhaps the most extraordinary technical feat in the Guthrie case involved video investigators initially believed did not exist. According to reporting highlighted by NBC News, authorities retrieved footage from backend infrastructure connected to a smart camera system -- data fragments not meant to be stored permanently.

That recovery required cooperation from engineers at Google and federal forensic specialists. Former bureau cyber official Timothy Gallagher explained that even when footage isn't saved to the cloud, it may still pass through multiple temporary storage points during transmission. Those fleeting fragments can sometimes be reconstructed if analysts know where -- and how -- to look.

Technology didn't stop at the house. The surrounding city itself became part of the investigation. Networks of automated license-plate readers from Flock Safety reportedly blanket the area, scanning vehicles and flagging anomalies such as unfamiliar cars appearing in a neighborhood at unusual hours. These systems don't just record plates; they analyze patterns.

Combined with inter-agency data platforms and camera-sharing networks, such tools allow law enforcement to trace a suspect's path across jurisdictions in minutes rather than weeks. The result is a kind of digital dragnet -- not a single net cast once, but thousands cast continuously.

China's humanoid robots take centre stage for Lunar New Year showtime

China's most-watched TV show, the annual CCTV Spring Festival gala, on Monday showcased the country's cutting-edge industrial policy and Beijing's push to dominate humanoid robots and the future of manufacturing.

Four rising humanoid robot startups - Unitree Robotics, Galbot, Noetix and MagicLab - demonstrated their products at the gala, a televised event and touchstone for China comparable to the Super Bowl for the United States.

The programme's first three sketches prominently featured humanoid robots, including a lengthy martial arts demonstration where over a dozen Unitree humanoids performed sophisticated fight sequences waving swords, poles and nunchucks in close proximity to human children performers.

Leaked US Air Force drone footage shows UFOs in airspace over Middle East

A recent New York Post report reveals that leaked U.S. Air Force surveillance drone footage appears to show unidentified aerial objects moving through military and civilian airspace over the Middle East, raising fresh questions about the nature and origin of unidentified aerial phenomena (UAPs).

According to the report, the videos were made public by investigative journalists and UAP researchers including George Knapp and Jeremy Corbell, who say the clips show objects that defy easy explanation.

One clip, captured on Aug. 23, 2012, allegedly shows three orb-like lights in a triangular formation over the Persian Gulf, recorded by an MQ-9 Reaper drone's infrared sensor.

These objects reportedly move abruptly without detectable heat or propulsion signatures—behavior that doesn't align with known aircraft technology.

Another video, thought to be from 2021 and filmed near the Syria–Jordan border, is said to show a similar circular object. Reporters note that this orb evaded radar tracking, disappearing from the system despite attempts to lock onto it, a detail that's fueling fresh curiosity and debate among UAP researchers and some military analysts.

Hangry Jesus? Rumbling stomach may have spurred iconic 'cleansing of the Temple'  
A new peer-reviewed article offers an alternative reading of the famous Gospel story that saw Jesus flipping the tables of merchants and moneychangers

A rumbling stomach might have been the reason why an upset Jesus flipped the tables of moneychangers and merchants as he visited Jerusalem ahead of the Passover holiday, claim a team of researchers in a new article published in the peer-reviewed journal "Cogent Arts & Humanities" in December.

The incident, known as the "cleansing of the Temple," has often been used in Christian rhetoric as a polemic against the Jewish leadership and system.

According to Dr. Haggai Olshanetsky, a researcher at the University of Warsaw, clergy and earlier scholars have mostly tried to understand the episode, present in all four Gospels, through the lens of the divine nature of Jesus. But, said Olshanetsky, a close textual reading coupled with the analysis of ancient Jewish sources and archaeological knowledge suggests that Jesus's human side and character could better explain the situation.

“There are many contradictions in the story,” Olshanetsky, one of the authors of the article, told The Times of Israel in a video call. “We asked ourselves how we could solve them. The element that most scholars have simply disregarded is that, even within Christianity, Jesus has two sides: human and divine. Everyone tried to explain [the incident] only in terms of the divine side. And we decided to look at the other option.”

Although each version presents different details, the story of Jesus turning the tables is included in the three Gospels of Mark, Matthew, and Luke, which are believed to have been written starting around the year 65 CE, and in the Gospel of John, dating to the last years of the 1st century CE. Experts generally agree on the historicity of the episode.

“And he entered the Temple and began to drive out those who sold and those who bought in the Temple, and he overturned the tables of the moneychangers and the seats of those who sold pigeons,” reads Mark (11:15). “And he would not allow anyone to carry anything through the Temple. And he was teaching them and saying to them, ‘Is it not written, ‘My house shall be called a house of prayer for all the nations?’ But you have made it a den of robbers.’”
