The case for imprisoning Donald Trump

Trump's status renders his offense far more serious and his behavior during the case indefensible, thus making a prison sentence more plausible.

Donald Trump has now been convicted of a felony. Nonetheless, many doubt that the former president will ever see the inside of a prison cell.

The doubters may be right — we'll find out what Judge Juan Merchan thinks at his July 11 sentencing hearing. But as a former state and federal prosecutor, the author of many works on criminal sentencing and a sentencing consultant to major white-collar criminal defendants, I think the factors usually considered in such cases would support sending Trump to prison.

Traditional white-collar sentencing factors include the seriousness of the offense, the history and character of the defendant (which can include the defendant's behavior before and after detection of the offense) and the need for the sentence to promote public respect for the law and provide just punishment to the defendant.

Trump's status as a former and aspiring future president adds an additional element unique to Judge Merchan's deliberations. One can fairly argue that imprisoning a former president for conduct related to his campaign could be unhealthy for the nation, inviting a cycle of tit-for-tat political prosecutions. This contention is perhaps even more compelling in the case of a former president running for another term. We know Trump's supporters will see any serious punishment as corrupt political persecution — just as they did the trial and the jury verdict.

However, in my view, Trump's status also renders his offense far more serious and his behavior during the case indefensible, thus making a prison sentence more plausible.

It was a rough few days for Micah Price, but in the end, he came out on top.

Price, a recent graduate of Campbell County High School in Alexandria, Kentucky, near Cincinnati, was finally awarded his diploma on Wednesday after the school withheld it because he spoke about his Christian faith during his commencement speech five days earlier.

WXIX-TV in Newport, Kentucky, reported that the young man submitted eight drafts of his speech to the school, which told him to take out portions that focused on his faith.

Price told the station it had been one of his goals since the fifth grade to deliver a speech on graduation day and he “prayed about it a lot.” As his opportunity was an answer to his prayers, he wanted to show his thanks to God, he said.

In spite of the school’s warning, Price decided to go off-script and honor God anyway at the end of his speech.

“Class, before another word is to leave my mouth, I must give the honor and the praise and the glory to my lord and savior, Jesus Christ,” he said.

“He is the way, the truth and the life,” Price said.

“Class, anyone in the audience tonight, I’m here to tell you that if you don’t have any of those things in your life, you can’t seem to find the answer, that my lord and savior is your answer.”

Many of those in attendance cheered the young man’s words of faith.

However, the school didn't have the same reaction. It decided to withhold his diploma.

Thankfully, Price was awarded his diploma on Wednesday.

Steve Bannon Ordered to Report to Federal Prison July 1

U.S. District Judge Carl Nichols ordered former Trump advisor Steve Bannon to report to federal prison on July 1. Bannon was convicted of contempt of Congress after not cooperating with a congressional subpoena regarding their investigation into the events of January 6, 2021. Nichols was nominated by former President Donald Trump in 2018, and assumed office in 2019.

In response to his bail being revoked, Bannon stated:

I've got great lawyers, and we're gonna go all the way to the Supreme Court if we have to. But I want to say something specifically about the Justice Department. Merrick Garland, Lisa Monaco, the entire Justice Department — they're not gonna shut up Trump, they're not gonna shut up [Peter] Navarro, they're not gonna shut up Bannon, and they're certainly not gonna shut up MAGA.

Marjorie Taylor Greene says Fauci should be jailed and rails against 'evil science' at Covid hearing

Dr Fauci, the former head of the NIAID, is facing questions from the GOP-led subcommittee investigating the US's Covid-19 response and the virus's origins

Infectious disease expert Anthony Fauci is facing questions from the House Select Committee on the Coronavirus Pandemic on Monday — marking his first Congressional testimony as a non-government official since stepping down in 2022.

Dr Fauci led the US's response to the Covid-19 pandemic, a role that earned him both praise and scrutiny alike. He is expected to face grilling from Congressional Republicans over the origins of the virus as well as transparency around government agency communications and records.

The former head of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID) is sitting for his first congressional testimony in almost two years.

The GOP-led subcommittee has requested access to Dr Fauci's personal email and phone records after obtaining information, which, they say, calls into question whether he may have attempted to conceal some records.

Dr Fauci is appearing voluntarily on Monday. He has said that he has "nothing to hide."

The divide between the Democrats and Republicans approach to the hearing is striking. One Democrat called this effort a "waste of time" while Republicans have pressed Fauci about conspiracies that have cropped up about the origins of Covid, including the lab leak theory and Fauci's alleged 'cover up'.

Covid vaccines may have helped fuel rise in excess deaths

Experts call for more research into side effects and possible links to mortality rates

Covid vaccines could be partly to blame for the rise in excess deaths since the pandemic, scientists have suggested.

Researchers from The Netherlands analysed data from 47 Western countries and discovered there had been more than three million excess deaths since 2020, with the trend continuing despite the rollout of vaccines and containment measures.

They said the “unprecedented” figures “raised serious concerns” and called on governments to fully investigate the underlying causes, including possible vaccine harms.

WHO chief Dr. Tedros has declared war on 'anti-vaxxers', vows to get 'more aggressive' with them

World Health Organization warns a NEW strain of bird flu has jumped to humans with 'potential for high public health impact' - as man in Mexico, 59, tests positive before dying from it

A new strain of bird flu has jumped to humans in an event that has 'potential for high public health impact', the World Health Organization has warned.

Officials say a 59-year-old man in Mexico died after battling a seven-day illness in which he suffered fever, shortness of breath, diarrhea and nausea.

Tests showed he was infected with a strain of bird flu called H5N2, marking the first time this type has ever been detected in humans.

The patient had no history of exposure to poultry or other animals. It is currently unclear how he became infected.

But officials said the risk to the public is 'low', adding that the patient had underlying health conditions. It was not clear whether the disease has spread to others.

However, the WHO said the man's infection and subsequent death has the 'potential for high public health impact'.

The patient, from Mexico City, became unwell on April 17, but waited a week before seeking help from his local hospital.

He died on the same day as his admission, however, because of the 'complications of his condition'.

PCR tests carried out on April 24 revealed he had been infected with a flu virus, and later it was confirmed that the patient had H5N2.

This differs from the H5N1 strain behind the outbreak in cattle which has sickened three people in the US this year.

Officials have tested 17 people at the Mexico hospital the patient attended , including one person who reported a runny nose. All tested negative.

Twelve people who lived near the patient's home in Mexico City — including seven with symptoms of illness — were also tested for bird flu, although all were negative.

Officials are now carrying out blood tests to screen for antibodies against the virus, which would reveal a previous infection.

The source of the infection is yet to be determined, although several flocks of poultry — which can carry H5N2 — have recently tested positive for the strain.

Ukraine hints it used Western weapons to strike inside Russia after Biden's green light

A senior Ukrainian official hinted Monday that, despite Kremlin threats, Kyiv may have already begun using Western weapons to hit targets inside Russia.

Ukraine finally has a green light to strike inside Russia using U.S. weapons — and it may have begun doing so.

A senior Ukrainian official hinted Monday that Kyiv had hit a missile system inside Russia using Western weapons, just days after many of Ukraine's allies, including the United States, approved their limited use.

That followed months of pressure to ignore threats from the Kremlin and lift the restrictions, which Ukraine said had hampered its defensive effort. Even as President Vladimir Putin's officials repeated their dire warnings, Ukraine signaled that it may have fired its first shots in this new reality, leaving observers to question what it could mean for the wider war.

A now-deleted post Monday on the Telegram messaging app from Ukrainian Deputy Prime Minister Iryna Vereshchuk showed a photo of what appears to be a burning military truck.

"It's burning well. This is a Russian S-300. On Russian territory. The first days after permission to use Western weapons on the enemy's territory," her post read.

Putin warns that Russia could provide long-range weapons to others to strike Western targets

President Vladimir Putin warned Wednesday that Russia could provide long-range weapons to others to strike Western targets in response to NATO allies allowing Ukraine to use their arms to attack Russian territory.

Putin also reaffirmed Moscow's readiness to use nuclear weapons if it sees a threat to its sovereignty.

The recent actions by the West will further undermine international security and could lead to "very serious problems," he said, taking questions from international journalists — something that has become extremely rare since Moscow sent troops into Ukraine.

"That would mark their direct involvement in the war against the Russian Federation, and we reserve the right to act the same way," Putin added.

Netanyahu warns: We're ready with 'extremely powerful' response to Hezbollah attacks

Visiting north, PM says Israel won't 'sit on its hands'; war cabinet split on timing of operation; Herzog urges world leaders to act before events spiral out of control

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu warned on Wednesday that Israel was prepared with an "extremely powerful" response to attacks from Hezbollah in Lebanon, which have escalated significantly in recent days.

"Anyone who thinks that they can harm us and that we will sit on our hands is sorely mistaken," Netanyahu said during a visit to the northern city of Kiryat Shmona, which has been largely evacuated since the Lebanon-based terror group began attacking Israeli communities and military posts along the border on a near-daily basis on October 8.

Hours later, at least 11 Israelis were wounded, one critically, in a Hezbollah-claimed attack with explosive-laden drones on the Druze-majority town of Hurfeish, located several kilometers from the Lebanon border.

Later, speaking at an event to commemorate Jerusalem Day, Netanyahu again vowed that Israel would restore calm to the north, whatever it takes.

"Iran is trying to choke us and encircle us and we are fighting back directly and with its proxies, Netanyahu said. "We can't accept the continuation of the situation in the north, it won't continue. We will return the resident to their homes and bring back security.

WORLD WAR III WATCH: NATO Drawing Up Plans to Deploy American Soldiers to the Front Line to Potentially Fight Russia in An All-Out War

The Daily Mail reported Tuesday that the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) is preparing plans to deploy American forces to the frontlines on the European continent to potentially fight a war with Russia.

Since the United States bears up to 70% of the total defense spending of all the countries in the NATO alliance, one can be sure they will provide a majority of these forces.

The ultimate goal of this developing scheme is to ensure that NATO forces can push through Europe without any unnecessary delays caused by local bureaucratic red tape and checkpoints, according to the Mail.

Bison gores South Carolina woman who got too close while visiting Yellowstone, NPS says

The bison lifted the 83-year-old woman about a foot off the ground while "defending its space," the National Park Service says.

A bison gored an 83-year-old woman Saturday at Yellowstone National Park.

Park emergency responders rushed her to a local medical clinic, where she was flown by helicopter to an Idaho hospital. Doctors said she sustained serious injuries.

The woman from Greenville, South Carolina, got too close to the bison, according to the National Park Service.

"The bison, defending its space, came within a few feet of the woman and lifted her about a foot off the ground with its horns," the NPS said in a statement.

Stretch of California beach closed after shark bites man during group swim

A stretch of beach in Del Mar was shut down for 24 hours. The swimmer suffered "significant" injuries but was expected to survive, the city said.

The tiny coastal city of Del Mar on Sunday shut down nearly its entire stretch of beaches after a shark attacked a man participating in a group swim, officials said.

The 46-year-old man was with about a dozen other swimmers who meet regularly to train in the cool waters north of San Diego when the shark attacked about 9 a.m., biting an arm, a hand and his torso, the city of Del Mar said in a statement.

He was rushed to a hospital in San Diego with "injuries that are significant but not believed to be life-threatening," the city said.

A hospital spokesperson said it couldn't provide the man's exact condition.

The attack happened about 100 yards from Del Mar's relatively new lifeguard headquarters on 17th Street, the city said. Lifeguards on duty closed a stretch of Del Mar beach to swimmers and surfers one mile north and south of the facility until 9 a.m. Monday, the city said.

First deadly black bear attack on human in California documented in Sierra County

The first documented case of a deadly black bear attack on a human in California history took place in Sierra County, according to the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The attack was in November 2023, but it took time for investigators to get to the bottom of exactly what happened.

“Downieville, being a pretty small, tight-knit community, everybody kind of takes care of everybody and keeps an eye out,” said Sierra County Sheriff Mike Fisher.

At first, a November call to the Sierra County Sheriff’s Office seemed standard.

“Our office got a request for a welfare check,” he explained.

Nothing prepared them for what came next.

“Something I had never seen before,” said the sheriff.

It all happened just steps away from his office.

“This is Patrice Miller’s house that she was living in,” Fisher said as she showed KCRA3 the home.

The 71-year-old woman had not been seen for a few days. So, a deputy came to check on her.

“Upon showing up, [they] immediately saw evidence of bear intrusion into the house,” Fisher said. “The door was broken. There was bear scat on the porch.”

Inside, there was a gruesome scene. The deputy found Miller dead, along with more clues into what happened.

“It appeared that the bear had probably been there several days and had been feeding on the remains.”

At the time, officials were saying that Miller likely died of natural causes before that bear broke in.

Even after the scene was cleared, the sheriff said the bear returned daily to the home in the heart of town.

“I was getting a lot of phone calls from concerned citizens that live in the area and other county employees,” Fisher said.

The sheriff said he called on the Department of Fish and Wildlife to help.

However, he said he was denied because the request to euthanize the bear had to come from a tenant or property owner.

“I had to relay several times that this individual was deceased and had been eaten by a bear,” Fisher said.

Eventually, a deputy determined Miller had been renting, and he was able to locate the property owner to secure a depredation permit.

A bear was trapped on the property.

Giant venomous flying spiders with 4-inch legs heading to New York area as they spread across East Coast, experts say

First came the spotted lanternflies, then the cicadas — and now, the spiders? The Northeast U.S. is bracing for an invasion of giant venomous spiders with 4-inch-long legs that can parachute through the air.

Earlier this year, New Jersey Pest Control warned of the incoming spiders, saying Joro spiders will be "hard to miss" as females have a leg span of up to 4 inches and are known for their vibrant yellow and grey bodies.

"What sets them apart, however, is their ability to fly, a trait uncommon among spiders," the company said. "While not accurate flight in the avian sense, Joro spiders utilize a technique known as ballooning, where they release silk threads into the air, allowing them to be carried by the wind."

A peer-reviewed study published last October by invasive species expert David Coyle found that the invasive species is "here to stay." The arachnids are native to Asia, but were introduced to north Georgia around 2010, the study said, and are continuing to spread. Experts have warned that the spiders could spread to New York since 2022, but none have been detected – yet.

"Anyone that doesn't sort of like all the creepy crawly things, this has all of the characteristics that makes them squeamish," Coyle previously told CBS News, saying a press release that "data show that this spider is going to be able to inhabit most of the eastern U.S.."

'Incredibly Significant': One Man's Quest for the Ark of the Covenant Takes Him Beneath the Temple Mount

For centuries, the search for the Ark of the Covenant has captured the imagination of movie makers, archeologists, and even a queen of England. Legends have placed the Ark in such faraway places as Ethiopia or Ireland.

Researcher and author Harry Moskoff took CBN News through the Western Wall tunnels, up to the ramparts of the Temple Mount, and into the chambers surrounding Judaism's holiest site. His book, *The A.R.K Report*, chronicles his two-decade quest to find the legendary icon.

He says one theory is that it was taken out of the Temple and carried to Jericho eighteen miles away.

“It says in Jeremiah that some of the vessels of the Temple were exited, sort of escaped as it were, through this area at the destruction of the First Temple,” he explained.

Moskoff took CBN News to the spot where he believes the Ark really lies.

He believes a key clue lies behind a 570-ton rock and says high-tech search tools give credence to his theory.

“Two years ago, there were tests done by the University of Nebraska, sonar tests...using electromagnetic waves. They actually found what’s called a storage space across from here,” said Moskoff.

“So actually, there was a purpose for putting this giant stone, this massive slab here. One of the reasons, in my opinion, is to protect whatever it is on the other side. And according to my theory of where the Ark was actually buried by King Josiah, I think it was 568 BC – in back of these boulders, these massive stones,” he said.

Underneath the Temple Mount lies dozens of underground tunnels and chambers.

“Back then, 150 years ago, Charles Warren went in and actually did a survey,” Moskoff said, adding that political tensions prevent anyone from excavating underneath the Temple Mount today.

“No one’s been allowed to even put a shovel, nothing. But, basically, they were the ones that surveyed the whole area and they were the ones who picked out the tunnels...They couldn’t find the Ark.”

This location is recorded in our sources, and today, there are those who know exactly where this chamber is.
