### SAUDI ARABIA 2024

Human rights defenders and others exercising their rights to freedom of expression and association were subjected to arbitrary arrest and detention, unfair trials leading to lengthy prison terms, and travel bans. Despite some limited labour reforms migrant workers, in particular domestic workers, continued to be subjected to forced labour and other forms of labour abuse and exploitation, and lacked access to adequate protection and redress mechanisms. Thousands of people were arrested and deported to their home countries, often without due process, as part of a government crackdown on individuals accused of violating labour, border and residency regulations. Saudi Arabia carried out executions for a wide range of crimes, including drug-related offences. Courts sentenced people to death following grossly unfair trials. Women continued to face discrimination in law and practice. Saudi Arabia failed to enact measures to tackle climate change and announced plans to increase oil production.

Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman has consolidated political and economic power, including as chairman of Saudi Arabia's Public Investment Fund (PIF), a sovereign wealth fund that has facilitated and benefited from rights abuses. PIF investments in high-profile sports and entertainment events domestically and internationally are used to whitewash the country's abysmal human rights record. Migrant workers, including on PIF-funded projects, face widespread abuses under the kafala (sponsorship) system. Saudi Arabian authorities harshly repress any

dissent, including by handing down long sentences or the death penalty after unfair trials on charges related to peaceful online expression.

There were no significant changes to the human rights situation in Saudi Arabia during the year.

Significant human rights issues included credible reports of: arbitrary or unlawful killings, including extrajudicial killings; enforced disappearance; torture and cruel, inhuman, or degrading treatment or punishment by government agents; harsh and life-threatening prison conditions; arbitrary arrest and detention; serious problems with the independence of the judiciary; political prisoners or detainees; transnational repression against individuals in another country; arbitrary or unlawful interference with privacy; punishment of family members for alleged offenses by a relative; serious restrictions on freedom of expression and media freedom, including violence or threats of violence against journalists, unjustified arrests or prosecutions of journalists, and censorship; serious restrictions on internet freedom; substantial interference with the freedom of peaceful assembly and freedom of association, including overly restrictive laws on the organization, funding, or operation of nongovernmental and civil society organizations; restrictions of religious freedom; restrictions on freedom of movement and residence within the territory of a state and on the right to leave the country; refoulement of refugees to a country where they would face torture or persecution; inability of citizens to change their government peacefully through free and fair elections; serious and unreasonable restrictions on political participation; serious government restrictions on domestic and international human rights organizations; crimes involving violence or threats of violence targeting migrants and refugees, especially of Ethiopian origin; laws criminalizing consensual same-sex sexual conduct between adults which were not enforced; crimes involving violence or threats of violence targeting lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, or intersex

persons; and prohibiting independent trade unions or significant restrictions on workers' freedom of association.

Despite the distorted media narrative, Christians thrive in Israel  
Coverage of the Cardinal Pizzaballa saga overlooks the reality of religious freedom in the Holy Land.

According to a nine-column front-page headline in La Repubblica, one of Italy's leading daily newspapers, the world can witness how difficult life supposedly is for Christians in Israel.

Indeed, the situation is portrayed as a "shock" for Christianity as a whole, especially for Cardinal Pierbattista Pizzaballa, the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem, who is depicted as a heroic figure "in conflict with [Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin] Netanyahu over the horrors of Gaza," and allegedly prevented by wicked Jews from going to pray at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

The facts tell a different story. In 1948, there were approximately 30,000 Christians in Israel; today, the number is close to 200,000. Christians in Israel are flourishing, which is certainly not the case in the Palestinian territories.

Consider Bethlehem, a city of profound importance to Christians as the birthplace of Jesus. In 1993, the year of the Oslo Accords, when control of the city was transferred to the Palestinian Authority and Israel withdrew, Christians constituted approximately 60–65% of the population. Today, that figure has fallen to roughly

15%. Christians have fled Palestinian rule, pushed out by discrimination, intimidation and the erosion of their cultural and religious freedoms.

Media reactions to the recent Jerusalem episode have been paradoxical, reflecting what increasingly appears to be an antisemitic fantasy that has gained traction since Oct. 7, 2023. An imagined defense of vulnerable victims is transformed into an accusation against Jews. In this fictional scenario, Iran and its bombardment disappear, replaced by the caricature of a supposedly anti-Christian Zionist monster.

The reality is that Christians in Israel live with equal rights and full freedom of worship, maintaining access to their holy sites. In contrast, Jewish communities across much of the Arab world have largely disappeared after decades of persecution, expulsion and violence. Yet little is said about this. Nor is much attention given to Christians persecuted and killed in parts of the Islamic world.

FBI says armed man who rammed his pickup into Michigan synagogue was inspired by Hezbollah

The armed man who rammed his pickup truck into a Detroit-area synagogue earlier this month was carrying out an attack inspired by Hezbollah, the Iran-backed Lebanese terror organization, the FBI says.

Ayman Ghazali made a video before the attack at Temple Israel in West Bloomfield Township, saying he wanted to “kill as many of them as I possibly can,” says Jennifer Runyan, head of the US investigative agency in Detroit.

“We assess this attack to be a Hezbollah-inspired act of terrorism purposely targeting the Jewish community and the largest Jewish temple in Michigan,” she says. “We do not make this characterization lightly without a thorough review and keen evaluation of the facts. In this case, the evidence shows the attacker was motivated and inspired by Hezbollah’s militant ideology.”

WHO and partners launch new initiative to expand use of digital health wallets

The World Health Organization (WHO) and the Alliance for Health Policy and Systems Research, in partnership with the Temasek Foundation, have launched a new three-year initiative to help Member States of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) transition from paper-based health records to secure, interoperable digital health wallets (DHWs). The programme aims to strengthen national health systems, improve continuity of care and ensure individuals have trusted, portable access to their essential health information.

“The COVID-19 pandemic showed how important it is for health records to be trusted, verifiable and able to travel with people across borders,” said Mr Kee Kirk Chuen, Head of Health & Well-being at the Temasek Foundation. “Through our partnership with WHO, the Temasek Foundation hopes to support countries in moving from fragmented paper records to secure Digital Health Wallets that individuals can carry with them wherever they go. By testing this approach in pilot ASEAN Member States we aim to demonstrate how trusted digital tools can strengthen health systems, improve continuity of care – including for families and children – and build the local capabilities needed for governments to scale these systems nationally. If successful, this effort can help turn global digital health standards into practical solutions that benefit communities across the region.” –

“Digital health wallets are more than a technological upgrade – they are a commitment to building trusted, people-centred health systems,” said Dr Alain Labrique, Director of the Data, Digital Health, Analytics and AI Department at WHO. “By supporting countries in adopting secure, interoperable solutions, we ensure that individuals can carry their essential health information with confidence and dignity. This partnership reflects our shared belief that digital transformation must strengthen national capacity, uphold equity, and provide the foundation for resilient health systems.”

UK to build new contact-tracing system and stockpile PPE under £1bn pandemic plan

First new preparedness strategy since 2011 focuses on a range of threats and includes funding for a new ‘biosecurity hub’

Britain will pre-emptively build a new contact tracing system and begin stockpiling PPE under a new, billion-pound plan to prepare for the next pandemic.

According to the plan, which was unveiled by the Department of Health and Social Care on Wednesday, the Government believes a new pandemic is a “certainty” but will be different from those that came before it, meaning plans must be flexible.

The strategy includes the introduction of an “All Pandemics Hazard Bill” – new legislation that would enable the government to rapidly adjust emergency measures based on how a disease spreads. The bill will be drafted by the Department of Health and Social Care and will be completed by March 2027.

Inside the stealthy startup that pitched brainless human clones

The ultimate plan to live forever is a brand new body.

After operating in secrecy for years, a startup company called R3 Bio, in Richmond, California, suddenly shared details about its work last week—saying it had raised money to create nonsentient monkey “organ sacks” as an alternative to animal testing.

In an interview with Wired, R3 listed three investors: billionaire Tim Draper, the Singapore-based fund Immortal Dragons, and life-extension investors LongGame Ventures.

But there is more to the story. And R3 doesn't want that story told.

MIT Technology Review discovered that the stealth startup's founder John Schloendorn also pitched a startling, medically graphic, and ethically charged vision for what he's called “brainless clones” to serve the role of backup human bodies. Imagine it like this: a baby version of yourself with only enough of a brain structure to be alive in case you ever need a new kidney or liver.

Or, alternatively, he has speculated, you might one day get your brain placed into a younger clone. That could be a way to gain a second lifespan through a still hypothetical procedure known as a body transplant.

The fuller context of R3's proposals, as well as activities of another stealth startup with related goals, have not previously been reported. They've been kept secret by a circle of extreme life-extension proponents who fear that their plans for immortality could be derailed by clickbait headlines and public backlash.

And that's because the idea can sound like something straight from a creepy science fiction film. One person who heard R3's clone presentation, and spoke on the condition of anonymity, was left reeling by its implications and shaken by Schloendorn's enthusiastic delivery. The briefing, this person said, was like a "close encounter of the third kind" with "Dr. Strangelove."

A key inspiration for Schloendorn is a birth defect in which children are born missing most of their cortical hemispheres; he's shown people medical scans of these kids' nearly empty skulls as evidence that a body can live without much of a brain.

And he's talked about how to grow a clone. Since artificial wombs don't exist yet, brainless bodies can't be grown in a lab. So he's said the first batch of brainless clones would have to be carried by women paid to do the job. In the future, though, one brainless clone could give birth to another.

Pope Leo hosts exorcist summit at the Vatican over fears of worldwide surge in Satanism

Pope Leo XIV hosted the world's most senior exorcists at the Vatican, who reportedly warned him of a terrifying global rise in "occultism, esotericism, and Satanism."

The Chicago-born head of the Catholic church held a private meeting with a delegation of Catholic priests from the International Association of Exorcists (AIE) this month, according to EWTN Vatican.

"They presented a report on the growing prevalence of cases related to occultism, esotericism, and Satanism, and the spiritual consequences they believe this has for many people," the outlet reported.

“During the meeting, the Association asked the Pontiff to ensure that every diocese in the world has one or more adequately trained exorcist priests.”

“During the audience, the Pope was also presented with the book Guidelines for the Ministry of Exorcism, along with an image of Saint Michael the Archangel from the sanctuary of Monte Sant’Angelo,” EWTN Vatican reported.

Luna Continues Transparency Investigation into UAPs

The House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform’s Task Force on the Declassification of Federal Secrets is continuing its investigation into Unidentified Aerial Phenomena (UAP) and the federal government’s continued lack of transparency surrounding the nature of these anomalies and potential security threats they pose. In a letter to U.S. Department of War Secretary Pete Hegseth, Task Force Chairwoman Anna Paulina Luna (R-Fla.) requests a series of video files related of UAP sightings.

“On September 9, 2025, the Task Force held a hearing focused on [UAP concerns.] Whistleblowers informed the Task Force that AARO [All-Domain Anomaly Resolution Office] possesses additional video records of potential UAP sightings. To continue its investigation, the Task Force requests certain video files related to UAP sightings,” wrote Task Force Chairwoman Luna.

Alien.gov mystery grows after White House says 'Stay tuned'

The domains come less than a month after President Donald Trump said he would order federal agencies to release government files related to "extraterrestrial life."

Two newly registered federal website domains – Alien.gov and Aliens.gov – are drawing attention after records showed they were created this week by a U.S. government agency, fueling speculation as questions around UFOs and extraterrestrial life return to the spotlight.

The timing is notable: The domains surfaced weeks after President Donald Trump said he would push for the release of government files related to UFOs and extraterrestrial life, reigniting debate over what information the federal government has kept classified.

In a statement provided to USA TODAY on March 19, White House Principal Deputy Press Secretary Anna Kelly said, "Stay tuned!" including an alien emoji after her message.
