Congressionally-Chartered Nonprofit's Disinformation Dashboard Used to Track Hunter Biden Laptop Story

Junkipedia, a dashboard for tracking and reporting "problematic content" created by the Algorithmic Transparency Institute (ATI), a project of the Congressionally-chartered National Conference on Citizenship (NCoC), was used to help discredit the Hunter Biden laptop story ahead of the 2020 election — linking the laptop story to "Pizzagate" and other conspiracy theories.

Rolled out in 2020, Junkipedia is a database for online censors to log examples of "problematic" speech so it can be tracked and, if necessary, escalated to Big Tech content moderators for suppression. ATI's parent, NCoC, is a purportedly nonpartisan nonprofit established by Congressional charter in 1953.

Junkipedia is digital public infrastructure for civic listening. Understanding how problematic content such as misinformation, hate speech, or junk news impact society requires shared tools to identify and archive that content. Junkipedia is a technology platform that enables manual and automated collection of data from across the spectrum of digital communication platforms including open social media, fringe networks, and closed messaging apps. The system is powered by the active engagement of a large and diverse network of civic-minded stakeholders from the civil rights, journalism, and academic communities.

Junkipedia is not the only government-linked censorship industry center that tried to cast doubt on the Hunter Biden laptop story. NewsGuard, arguably the most influential censorship organization, which operates by blacklisting and whitelisting online news sites and is backed by \$750,000 in Pentagon funds, was also caught in the disinformation trap, in which the censorship industry revealed its capacity to spread disinformation that favored its agenda

ormer President Trump compared the death of Russian opposition leader Alexei Navalny to his legal problems Monday, saying it had made him "more aware" of what is happening in this country.

The remarks about Navalny are Trump's first since the 47-year-old's death in prison, which President Biden has blamed on Russian President Vladimir Putin.

Trump did not mention Putin in his remarks on Truth Social, and instead pivoted to a recitation of his complaints about prosecutors, judges and Democrats conspiring against him. On Friday, Trump was ordered to pay a \$355 million payment as part of civil fraud trial decision.

"The sudden death of Alexei Navalny has made me more and more aware of what is happening in our Country," Trump wrote on Truth Social. "It is a slow, steady progression, with CROOKED, Radical Left Politicians, Prosecutors, and Judges leading us down a path to destruction. Open Borders, Rigged Elections, and Grossly Unfair Courtroom Decisions are DESTROYING AMERICA. WE ARE A NATION IN DECLINE, A FAILING NATION!"

Pastor Jack Hibbs Triggers Atheists With U.S. Capitol Praye

The Freedom From Religion Foundation is protesting the U.S. House inviting Pastor Jack Hibbs to open the session with prayer, calling the invitation "reprehensible."

Hibbs opened his prayer in Congress saying "Let's pray. Almighty God and Father our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, together we come before you in humility as the people in need of your forgiveness."

Hibbs continued: "I ask you today, Father, to bring us to a great awakening of righteousness and confidence in you, who alone is mighty to save. Hear my cry in this hour of great need that we might be humbly blessed before you in the repentance of our national sins."

The atheist group is protesting who they call a "vengeful zealot," being invited to open Congress with the prayer. A conflict of what they believe to be an invasion of separation of church and state.

The Foundation wrote, "Why didn't the (undoubtedly few) members of Congress present rise en masse out of self-respect and walk out?"

"It's time in a nation predicated on a secular Constitution to end this congressional exercise in piety and pandering. Anti-LGBTQ+ hate pastor gives opening prayer in House of Representatives Jack Hibbs said that Satan created the "transgender agenda" and rallied the faithful to support conversion therapy.

A Christian pastor with a long history of anti-LGBTQ+ comments was invited to be the guest chaplain of the House of Representatives yesterday.

Rev. Jack Hibbs of Calvary Chapel in Chino Hills, California, gave the opening prayer at the House yesterday morning. In his prayer, he called the Constitution God's "great gift to all freedom-loving people" but otherwise stayed away from political topics.

Hibbs is a controversial figure in Christianity because of his extreme antipathy towards LGBTQ+ people. Just last year, he said that "Satan himself" planned the "transgender agenda." He said that teachers should out LGBTQ+ students to their parents in order to fight the "demonic and dark satanic powers" in public schools that are "sexualizing" and "mentally abusing" children.

"Transgenderism is a violation of the word and will of God," he said. "It's a violation of humanity. It's a violation of science. It's a violation — if you're an evolutionist — regarding evolution."

Hibbs is also a supporter of conversion therapy, the harmful pseudoscientific process by which LGBTQ+ people are converted to be straight and cisgender. In 2018, he spoke at a rally in Sacramento alongside the ex-LGBTQ+ group "Changed" opposing A.B. 2943, a bill that would have labeled conversion therapy a form of "consumer fraud" in the state because practitioners make promises they can't deliver on.

"The entire gospel is about change. It is about hope," he said at the rally. "The very gospel message is that Jesus Christ changes lives."

Lawmakers are asking for answers after a guest chaplain known for his incendiary preaching was sponsored by Speaker Mike Johnson to give the House's daily opening prayer last month, according to a letter sent to the speaker and the Office of the Chaplain signed by 26 Democratic House members.

Hibbs should not have been allowed to deliver the opening prayer on Jan. 30, argues the letter, which was led by Reps. Jared Huffman of California, Jamie Raskin of Maryland and Mark Pocan of Wisconsin.

Pro-Life Legal Group Asks Court to Dismiss Bogus Case Against Sandra Merritt, Who Exposed Planned Parenthood

Liberty Counsel filed an appeal to the California First District Court of Appeal pursuing the dismissal of the criminal case against Sandra Merritt brought by former California Attorney General Xavier Becerra for her undercover journalism and videos which exposed Planned Parenthood's trade in baby body parts.

Liberty Counsel's appeal asks the State Court of Appeal to dismiss the remaining criminal counts because those counts are based on California's recording law. The Ninth Circuit federal Court of Appeals recently ruled that Oregon's substantially similar recording law violates the First Amendment Free Speech Clause.

In a recent precedent set by the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals in Project Veritas v. Schmidt, Oregon's similar ban on surreptitious recordings of conversations was determined to be a content-based restriction infringing on free speech. California's Penal Code section 632(a) is nearly identical to Oregon's unconstitutional statute. It should suffer the same fate and Merritt's case should be dismissed.

The Alabama Supreme Court Was Right: Unborn Babies are Human Beings

The Yellowhammer State's highest court is ruling that frozen embryos are legally children under state law. In a ruling issued Friday, Alabama's Supreme Court declared that "the Wrongful Death of a Minor Act applies to all unborn children, regardless of their location." The relevant case involved the question of whether or not parents could sue after their cryogenically frozen embryos were accidentally destroyed by an employee at a fertility clinic.

"The parties to these cases have raised many difficult questions," wrote Justice Jay Mitchell in the court's opinion, "including ones about the ethical status of extrauterine children, the application of the 14th Amendment to the United States Constitution to such children, and the public-policy implications of treating extrauterine children as human beings." However, the court determined that it did not need to answer each question raised, stating that ultimately "the relevant statutory text is clear: the Wrongful Death of a Minor Act applies on its face to all unborn children, without limitation."

Alabama's Wrongful Death of a Minor Act was enacted in 1872 and, according to the court, regards unborn babies as human beings and children. The justices provided extensive examples of definitions of the term "child" throughout the state's legal history, including two relatively recent decisions — 2011's "Mack v. Carmack" and 2012's "Hamilton v. Scott" — which both affirmed that "Alabama's wrongful-death statute allows an action to be brought for the wrongful death of any unborn child." But, the court noted, "Even if the word 'child' were ambiguous ... the Alabama Constitution would require courts to resolve the ambiguity in favor of protecting unborn life."

Are Scientific Journals Knowingly Publishing False Research To Promote Abortion Ideology?

Planned Parenthood, the leading proponent of abortion in America, has written on their website, "Medication abortion is really safe and effective. It's a super common way to have an abortion, and millions of people have used it safely." Planned Parenthood broadcasts that abortion is a "right," that any method of terminating a baby in the womb is safe, and that complications are "extremely rare."

However, several experts have pointed out that Planned Parenthood — along with other businesses that carry out abortions — are especially prone to dressing up poor or false data, research, and arguments to serve their agenda.

Chemical abortion has become a focal point in this debate, since its use has spiked significantly since Roe v. Wade was overturned in 2022.

The abortion drug mifepristone has been strongly promoted as an alternative to women who want an abortion but live in pro-life states. Women are told that the abortion pill is safe and easy, as it can be done in one's own home. Several universities across America have required access to the abortion pill, and as potential restrictions to the pill circulate in the media, research has revealed that women have stocked up on it "just in case."

But medical professionals and pro-life advocates are trying to bring awareness to research that reveals chemical abortion is anything but safe.

Many women have shared their testimonies from using the abortion pill. Kelly Lester, Outreach Director for And Then There Were None, talked openly about her pain after four abortions. "The abortion pill was the worst," she insisted. "Women aren't getting the full story." Like so many others, Lester said her experience is one of grief and agony. But these testimonies are ignored by mainstream media.

Dr. Ingrid Skop, vice president and director of medical affairs at the Charlotte Lozier Institute, highlighted the flaws in this study. The fact that the outcome of at least a quarter of the women involved was unknown "should disqualify the study," she said. "If

you don't know what happened to one out of four women, you cannot assume that those were uncomplicated."

Skop, who is also a fellow of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, said she's seen "so many women harmed by abortion drugs," adding that what she's seen on the ground is proof that it's not safe. "This study is the latest in a long series of demonstrations that the pro-abortion medical organizations and the pro-abortion scientific journals are now publishing what they know is poor quality research in order to promote abortion ideology," she said.

A nationwide cellphone outage struck the United States on Thursday morning and impacted more than 70,000 customers. The issue apparently started with AT&T's network, but has affected customers who use Verizon and T-Mobile as well. The problem is serious — it has impacted emergency services such as 911. While the reason for the outage has not yet been revealed, there's no indication it was due to an intentional or malicious act.

Rubio warns Chinese cyberattack 'will be 100 times worse' than AT&T outage: 'Your power, your water'

Tens of thousands of people reported cellphone outages on Thursday

GOP Sen. Marco Rubio warned on social media that the AT&T outage affecting tens of thousands of Americans pales in comparison to what a potential China cyberattack would look like.

"I don't know the cause of the AT&T outage," the Florida Republican posted on X on Thursday. "But I do know it will be 100 times worse when #China launches a cyber attack on America on the eve of a #Taiwan invasion.

"And it won't be just cell service they hit, it will be your power, your water and your bank."

Rubio's warning came as tens of thousands of AT&T customers reported outages on Thursday morning for their home phone, internet and mobile phone services, according to Downdetector.

The outages started popping up just before 3:30 a.m. ET, according to a graph shown on the website that tracks outages.

Most users, 54%, say they are having issues with mobile phone service. More than a third of customers reporting being affected say they have no signal at all, and 8% of users say their mobile internet is down.

"Some of our customers are experiencing wireless service interruptions this morning," AT&T told FOX Business in a statement. "We are working urgently to restore service to them. We encourage the use of Wi-Fi calling until service is restored."

More than 74,000 AT&T users reported outages to Downdetector as of 9:30 a.m. ET.

Earlier this month, FBI director Christopher Wray warned that China's cyberattacks against the U.S. and its allies are reaching a "fever pitch."

"You might find your companies harassed and hacked, targeted by a web of corporate CCP proxies," Wray told the leaders gathered in Germany. "You might also find PRC [People's Republic of China] hackers lurking in your power stations, your phone companies and other infrastructure, poised to take them down when they decide you stepped too far out of line, and that hurting your civilian population suits the CCP."

"China-sponsored hackers pre-positioned for potential cyberattacks against U.S. oil and natural gas companies way back in 2011, but these days, it's reached something closer to a fever pitch," he continued. "What we're seeing now is China's increasing build-out

of offensive weapons within our critical infrastructure, poised to attack whenever Beijing decides the time is right."

The Pfizer Law? Statists Now Aim to Arrest People Who Reject "Medical Knowledge"

"Consensus is the business of politics," said late author Michael Crichton in 2003. "Science, on the contrary, requires only one investigator who happens to be right." While true, being right and doing actual science may get you arrested under a bill that just passed in France's National Assembly — if your activities are deemed contrary to "medical knowledge."

The problem is that "medical knowledge" has a history of fallibility, with bloodletting and lobotomies once having been standard practice based on "medical knowledge." More recently, we heard Dr. Anthony Fauci say that "attacks on me quite frankly are attacks on science" as he claimed final-authority status on medical knowledge. Yet some of his pronouncements were very, very wrong.

As for the bill, it might apply only to those pressuring a particular individual or individuals to act contrary to establishment medicine. Yet critics fear it could mean imprisonment for criticizing Covid mRNA injections. Moreover, those skeptical about the "transgender" agenda could be victimized as well, as the measure also reportedly targets those deemed to be harming "psychological health."

The World Council for Health (WCH) reports on the story:

On 14th February 2024, the French Parliament adopted amendments to an existing anticult law. The measures voted on by parliamentarians include the highly controversial Article 4 criminalizing medical dissent by criminalizing any individual criticizing or encouraging others to avoid mainstream medical practices or health policies, assuming such avoidance can be claimed by authorities to do harm. These include not only thousands of scientists and medical doctors but also people from all walks of life in towns and communities across France. The motives driving this law were clearly stated in the Explanatory Memorandum by French Minister of the Interior, Mr Gérald Darmanin asserting, "The health crisis has provided an ideal breeding ground for ... self-proclaimed 'gurus' or 'masters of thought' [who] operate online, taking advantage ... of social networks to federate real communities around them."

Coincidently [sic], the law has been introduced whilst the French government is suing one of France's top virologists for publishing a study that found alternative Covid treatments resulted in better results than the government's treatment protocol. The suit was filed against physician and infectious diseases specialist Dr Didier Raoult, even though the hospital he managed had one of the lowest Covid mortality rates of any hospital.

The bill ... constitutes a clear and direct attack on civil rights, freedom of speech, and scientific inquiry and is a blatant attack on the practice of alternative and natural medicine. It establishes state-sponsored scientific truth — a single truth established by the State — in other terms, tyranny and fascism.

Hamas Spokesman Blames Israel's Importing 'Red Heifers' For October Attack

When Abu Obeida, a military spokesman for Hamas, began his televised speech marking 100 days since the October 7 attack last week, most of what he said followed the familiar mantra of praising Hamas' military resistance and calling for all Muslims to rise against Israel. But as he began listing the motives for the October 7 massacre, he said that the aggression against "our path and Al-Aqsa" reached its peak with the "bringing of red cows."

To much of the world, such a statement sounds strange, as they are not aware of traditional Jewish beliefs regarding the "Parah Adumah", the red heifers used for purification. The "bringing of red cows" which Obeida was referring to was the 2022 arrival of five red heifers to the Temple Institute, a Jewish organization focused on establishing the Third Temple on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem. The heifers are quietly being groomed by the Institute for their ultimate goal.

The rare animal is the main component in a ritual purification ceremony for cleansing ritual impurity from proximity or contact with a dead body. Since the destruction of the Second Temple, all Jews today are considered ritually impure, thereby preventing the return of the Temple service and even entering the holy places on Temple Mount.

Shabbat Parah for Hebrew Year 5784 begins at sundown on Friday, 29 March 2024 and ends at nightfall on Saturday, 30 March 2024. This corresponds to Parashat Tzav.

Shabbat Parah ("Sabbath [of the] red heifer" שבת פרה) takes place on the Shabbat before Shabbat HaChodesh, in preparation for Passover. Numbers 19:1-22 describes the parah adumah ("red heifer") in the Jewish temple as part of the manner in which the kohanim and the Jewish people purified themselves so that they would be ready ("pure") to sacrifice the korban Pesach.

"This is the decree of the Torah, which Hashem has commanded, saying: Speak to the Children of Israel, and they shall take to you a completely red cow, which is without blemish, and upon which a yoke has not come." (BaMidbar 19:2)

This is an example of Law of the Torah which is considered completely above human comprehension. The paradox is that those who are involved in the preparation of the ashes of the cow become ritually impure, while the sprinkling of water with those ashes is used to remove contamination! It is an example of a Law which must be accepted on faith alone.

On the Shabbat after Purim, two Torah Scrolls are removed from the Ark. The Sidrah of the week is read from the first, and from the second, the chapter of Parah Adumah, the Red Cow (or Red Heifer), is read. It gives the procedure through which people can purify themselves from the contamination caused by a human corpse.

The reading of this chapter was instituted for this time of the year because Jews were required to purify themselves before coming to Jerusalem for the pilgrimage festival of Passover.

The Haftarah read on the Sabbath of Parashat Parah contains the verse, "And I shall sprinkle pure water upon you, that you be cleansed. From all your contamination and from all your filth I will cleanse you" (Ezekiel 36:25). There are other parallels in the Haftarah between the concepts of sin represented by contamination, and atonement represented by purity.
