### BRICS Summit Begins with Goal of Ditching U.S. Dollar

The foreign ministers of BRICS member nations – and another 13 countries interested in collaborating with the anti-Western bloc – convened in Russia on Monday for a meeting outside of the confines of the BRICS annual summit to discuss, among other issues, ways to expand trade without the use of the U.S. dollar.

“The proactive work is underway on fulfillment of decisions of the Johannesburg summit of the last year, specifically as regards improvement of the international monetary system and development of a platform for payment in national currencies in mutual trade,” Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov said on Monday.

The vast majority of international trade is conducted using the U.S. dollar, bolstering the strength of the American currency and leaving nations open to potential sanctions damage. Given the growing number of sanctions imposed on Russia and China in response to a litany of human rights abuses committed by their dictatorships, both countries have spearheaded efforts both in BRICS and beyond to “de-dollarize” their economies, ideally rendering them immune from sanctions.

“Why can’t an institution like the BRICS bank have a currency to finance trade relations between Brazil and China, between Brazil and all the other BRICS countries?” socialist Brazilian President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva said in April 2023. “Who decided that the dollar was the currency (for trade) after the end of the gold parity?”

### China’s US Debt Sales Fuel Speculation

Talk of de-dollarization is back on the table after new data from the US Treasury Department revealed that China offloaded close to \$50 billion in US Treasuries in the first quarter and had reduced its holdings by more than \$100 billion in the year through to March 2023. The revelations come as China and the US are locked in an increasingly tense stand-off involving trade and China's intentions toward Taiwan.

Belgium, which is often referenced as a proxy custodian for China's debt holdings, reportedly disposed of more than \$20 billion of Treasuries in the same period.

Not everyone is convinced China's US debt sales represent anything aggressive as opposed to a routine realignment of debt management activities by the world's second largest economy. But the question whether Beijing is dumping US debt, combined with a potential broader adoption of the renminbi, suggests the US government will need a strategy to manage the impact on perceptions of the greenback as the world's reserve currency.

“The core issue of whether China has diversified at the margin out of the dollar/dollar bonds or has diversified its set of custodians beyond the US custodians and Euroclear remains unresolved,” Brad Setser, senior fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations, wrote on X, formerly known as Twitter, last month.

### Saudi Arabia Exits US Petrodollar Deal

The financial markets are bracing for disruption now that Saudi Arabia decided not to renew its 50-year petrodollar partnership with the United States, MSN reported.

This opens the door for Saudi Arabia to sell oil and other goods — instead of exclusively in the U.S. dollar — in multiple other currencies, including the Chinese renminbi, and in euros, yen, and digital currencies such as bitcoin.

Saudi Arabia's shift to other currencies is expected to hasten the global movement away from the dollar.

The contract, originally signed on June 8, 1974, expired on June 9, 2024, although the petrodollar system was established in 1972, when the U.S. decoupled its currency from gold.

The 1974 security agreement that the U.S. and Saudi Arabia signed heralded close cooperation between the two countries by establishing two joint commissions, one on economic cooperation and the second on Saudi Arabia's military needs.

Saudi Arabia recently announced it joined Project mBridge to explore a multilateral bank digital currency (CBDC) platform involving central and commercial banks. The CBDC is built on a distributed ledger technology for instant cross-border payment settlements and foreign exchange transactions.

More than 26 nations are mBridge members, including Federal Reserve Bank of New York, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, European Central Bank, Reserve Bank of Australia, Bank of Israel, Bank of France, Central Bank of Bahrain, Central Bank of Egypt, Central Bank of Jordan, Bank of Namibia, and South African Reserve Bank.

Five financial institutions spearheaded Project mBridge with extensive collaboration that started in 2021. They are the BIS Innovation Hub, the Bank of Thailand, Central Bank of the United Arab Emirates, Digital Currency Institute of the People's Bank of China, and the Hong Kong Monetary Authority.

G7 leaders agree to lend Ukraine billions backed by Russia's frozen assets. Here's how it will work

Leaders of the Group of Seven wealthy democracies have agreed to engineer a \$50 billion loan to help Ukraine in its fight for survival. Interest earned on profits from Russia's frozen central bank assets would be used as collateral.

Details of the deal were being hashed out by G7 leaders at their summit in Italy. The money could reach Kyiv before the end of the year, according to U.S. and French officials.

President Joe Biden told reporters at a news conference Thursday that the move was part of a “historic agreement.” Ukraine’s president, Volodymyr Zelenskyy, said providing a loan through Russia’s assets “is a vital step forward in providing sustainable support for Ukraine in winning this war.”

Here’s how the plan would work:

Where would the money come from?

Most of the money would be in the form of a loan mostly guaranteed by the U.S. government, backed by profits being earned on roughly \$260 billion in immobilized Russian assets. The vast majority of that money is held in European Union nations.

Biden and Zelensky to ink 10-year deal meant to lock in U.S. military support for Ukraine: framework could box in Trump with U.S. election up for grabs

President Joe Biden is set to sign a deal with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky intended to commit the U.S. to a decade of military support – a move that could pressure rival Donald Trump if he takes the White House.

The move is a key 'deliverable' of Biden's G7 meetings set to begin in the Apulia region of Italy Thursday. The president arrived last night, and meets one on one with Zelensky before the two leaders are set to hold a joint press conference Thursday evening local time.

'We want to demonstrate that the U.S. supports the people of Ukraine, that we stand with them, and that we’ll continue to help address their security needs not just tomorrow but out into the future,' White House National Security Advisor Jake Sullivan told reporters aboard Air Force One en route to the annual confab.

Europe's far right won ground in the EU elections. Can they unite to wield power?

The next European Parliament will have more hard-right members than ever before, occupying close to a quarter of the 720 seats. But they will have to overcome differences if they want to maximize their influence on the EU policies that roil their constituents: migration, climate rules and farming.

The loose centrist coalition that has controlled the European Union's only directly elected body for decades maintained a narrow majority in last week's voting. But stunning results by far-right parties in France, Germany and beyond have jolted the bloc, which was founded after the defeat of Nazi Germany in World War II.

Parties such as France's National Rally, the Brothers of Italy, and Alternative for Germany (AfD) must work together to have a significant impact on EU policy.

Their members are currently spread across different groups in the European Parliament: the nationalist European Conservatives and Reformists, the Identity and Democracy Group — home to the most hard-right factions — plus a large number of unaligned parties.

Biden to lift ban on Ukrainian unit using US weapons, Wash Post reports

The Biden administration will lift its ban on allowing a controversial Ukrainian military unit to use U.S. weapons, the Washington Post reported on Monday, citing State Department officials.

The State Department reversed a decade-old prohibition on the Azov Brigade from using American training and weapons after a new analysis found no evidence of human rights violations by the unit, the Post reported.

Russian warships hold missile drills in the Atlantic on their way to Cuba

The Russian defense ministry said on Tuesday that a Russian naval frigate and a nuclear-powered submarine carried out missile exercises in the Atlantic Ocean while heading to Cuba.

The submarine Kazan and the warship Admiral Gorshkov launched high-precision missiles at simulated enemy targets from over 600 kilometers (370 miles) away. Additionally, the Admiral Gorshkov recently trained to defend against an air attack, Russian defense ministry said.

The ships are part of a group of four Russian warships scheduled to arrive in Cuba on Wednesday.

The Admiral Gorshkov is equipped with the latest Zircon hypersonic missiles, AP reported. This weapon, intended for Russian cruisers, frigates, and submarines, can target both enemy ships and ground installations.

House Holds Attorney General Merrick Garland in Contempt of Congress

The House of Representatives voted Wednesday to hold Attorney General Merrick Garland in contempt of Congress for refusing to comply with Congressional subpoenas.

The vote easily cleared, given House Republicans' thin margins, in a 216 to 207 vote after a day of deliberation.

The House Committees on Oversight and Accountability and Judiciary issued subpoenas to Garland on February 27, 2024, for records related to Special Counsel Robert Hur's investigation of President Joe Biden's willful mishandling of classified information.

Most importantly, Republicans wanted the audio tapes of Hur's interview with Biden. Garland had only provided written transcripts, which Republicans said were insufficient after Hur revealed that Biden experienced mental lapses and "poor memory" during his interview.

Six suspected terrorists with ISIS ties arrested in sting operation in New York, Los Angeles and Philadelphia: sources

Six Russian nationals suspected to have terror ties to ISIS have been arrested in a coordinated sting operation spanning Los Angeles, New York and Philadelphia, The Post can exclusively reveal.

Two ICE sources confirmed to The Post they arrested the six people, who hail from Tajikistan, over the last week after the FBI contacted the agency to warn it.

Two others who were part of the same group were also arrested after being under surveillance for "several months" by a multi-agency Joint Terrorism Task Force, according to NBC.

Part of the investigation featured a wiretap which revealed one of the now-arrested individuals was talking about bombs, the sources said.

Buttigieg Takes Veiled Shot At Samuel Alito's Wife By Smearing Patriotic Flag As 'Insurrectionist Symbology'

Secretary of Transportation Pete Buttigieg on Wednesday appeared to attack U.S. Supreme Court Justice Samuel Alito's wife by characterizing a flag she allegedly displayed as "insurrectionist symbology."

Martha-Ann Alito allegedly displayed an upside-down American flag and an "Appeal to Heaven" flag outside of homes the couple own, both of which The New York Times claimed were associated with the Jan. 6 Capitol riot. Host John Berman asked Buttigieg on "CNN News Central" how he feels about Martha-Ann saying in a secret recording that she wants to "send ... a message" to people flying Pride flags by flying a Christian flag, with the secretary drawing a contrast seeming to criticize the Supreme Court justice's wife.

"They are entrusted with it literally for as long as they live and part of that trust is we expect them to enter into those enormously consequential decisions that shape our everyday lives with a sense of fairness. I also hope that most Americans can understand the difference between a flag that symbolizes love and acceptance and signals to people who have sometimes feared for their safety that they're gonna be okay, and insurrectionist symbology. I'll just leave it at that," he added.

Alito said in May that neither he nor his wife had knowledge of the "Appeal to Heaven" flag's relationship to the "Stop the Steal Movement." George Washington commissioned the flag and it was flown during the American Revolution.

Popular fitness center labels pride, BLM 'freedom of expression,' bans American flag

A memo circulated internally at 24 Hour Fitness is reportedly labeling symbols associated with Black Lives Matter and LGBT Pride as "freedom of expression" while banning patriotic imagery — like the American flag — except for on certain U.S. holidays.

The letter first obtained by the viral social media activist behind Libs of TikTok reportedly states employees should "bring their full selves to work every day" and



encourages staffers — which the company calls “team members” — to dress in apparel that shows “solidarity and support” for specific causes.

Employees at the gym chain are allowed — at all times — to wear clothing with phrases and images supporting Black Lives Matter, LGBT Pride, and Juneteenth. The memo further states patriotic apparel with the “[U.S.] Flag or United States logo” is only permitted “on holidays such as Memorial Day, Flag Day, July 4th, Veteran’s Day, Patriots Day, etc.”

Pentagon official reveals tantalizing seven-minute encounter with glowing blue UFO - which emitted enough energy to 'power a small city'

A US Department of Defense contractor's tantalizing encounter with a giant, glowing UFO has sparked 10 years of research and two patents inspired by his encounter.

Three witnesses, including that Pentagon engineer, report that they captured electronic evidence of a 'barbell' UFO, half the length of a football field, that glowed an eerie 'indigo' blue.

The craft, they said, flew silently over an old logging road in southwestern Ontario, Canada, on August 28, 2013, near where the trio had camped for a hunting trip.

DailyMail.com spoke with the case's first investigators, who shared electronic data from the contractor's attempt to film the object — showing 'white noise' pulses in the video that recur in one-second loops identical to strobing light from the UFO itself.

'The captured data of the event,' the witness reported, 'may be the first real physical proof of not just a craft flying, but that it flies by virtue of an incredibly complex and [...] powerful spinning electromagnetic propulsion system.'

The case was investigated by the same nanotechnology expert whose analysis of a 2007 mass UFO sighting in Texas became a centerpiece of the Steven Spielberg-produced UFO docuseries 'Encounters' last year on Netflix.

'Is there another 'barbell' case we've investigated like this?' that engineer, UFO investigator Robert Powell, told DailyMail.com of this rare case. 'No, it's the only one.'

Powell told DailyMail.com that UFO cases with this shape are so rare that only about '50 to 60 cases' exist 'throughout history.'

Powell, whose new book on UFOs has garnered praise from former Defense Department intelligence official Chris Mellon, personally visited the contractor's lab and worked with him on analyzing the eerie interference on his UFO video.

'He gave me a tour of the defense facility,' Powell said, who vetted the source's identity and biographical claims.

## Supreme Court Rejects Challenge to Abortion Drug Mifepristone

Lower courts previously ruled the government improperly rolled back safety-related restrictions on the drug.

The Supreme Court unanimously rejected a challenge on June 13 that was brought by a doctors' group against the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA's) loosening of regulations of the abortion pill mifepristone, handing a win to the agency.

The court held that those challenging the status of the pill lacked the legal standing to do so.

The decision came two years after the court's landmark 2022 ruling in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*, which overturned *Roe v. Wade* and returned the regulation of abortion to the states.

President Joe Biden quickly hailed the new decision, describing mifepristone as "safe and effective."

He also criticized Republicans, saying their "attacks on medication abortion are part of ... [an] extreme and dangerous agenda to ban abortion nationwide."

Since *Roe v. Wade* was reversed, "Republican elected officials have imposed extreme abortion bans in 21 states, some of which include zero exceptions for rape or incest," the president said in a written statement.

The 9–0 opinion was written by Justice Brett Kavanaugh. Justice Clarence Thomas filed a concurring opinion.

Medication abortions are reportedly lawful in 36 states and the District of Columbia.

A medication abortion generally involves the use of mifepristone, which blocks progesterone, a hormone, and misoprostol, which induces contractions.

Misoprostol, which is widely available because it has many medical uses, wasn't an

issue in the current litigation. Also known as mifeprex and RU-486, mifepristone is made by Danco Laboratories.

In 2023, nearly two-thirds of U.S. abortions were performed using medication, largely thanks to a company few have heard of: Danco Laboratories. The company's sole product is mifepristone, half of the two-drug regimen used to induce early-pregnancy abortions. For almost 25 years, Danco's executives kept quiet to avoid attracting the wrath of anti-abortion activists. But after Danco landed last year at the center of an ongoing Supreme Court case that threatens the availability of mifepristone, its leaders decided to speak out about the importance of access to the safe and effective abortion medication, says vice president of marketing and operations Abby Long. Danco, she says, also wants to set a precedent, defending other scientifically proven drugs from political attacks. "On its face it feels like it's just about abortion," Long says. "In the end it's not."

The secrecy surrounding the abortion pill's maker and influential financial investors must end

Another issue is that the abortion pill's manufacturer itself is incredibly secretive about its stakeholders and controlling parties, which (from the limited information we can glean) appear to stand to gain financially from a broad abortion pill expansion.

Additional investors in DANCO: George Soros (Open Society Foundation), Warren Buffett (Buffett Foundation) and the California-based Kaiser Family Foundation.

Shrouded in secrecy

According to the Washington Post (2000), the FDA “took the unprecedented step of refusing to disclose the name or location of the manufacturer” of the abortion pill. The Washington Post (2000) also reported that the “agency broke with precedent by not publishing the names of the experts who reviewed RU-486 for the agency.” The LA Times noted (2000), “Danco refuses to release the names of its executives and investors. The company even persuaded the Food and Drug Administration to keep secret the location of the factory where the abortion drug will be produced.... The FDA acceded to Danco’s request that the name of its manufacturer be kept secret — and even shielded the names of the FDA researchers who had overseen the pill’s approval.”

2. The Packard Foundation, a large investor in the abortion pill:

In 1998, Packard seeded DANCO with \$10 million. Packard’s investment in the company included a \$14 million loan as early as 1996 to bring the drug to the U.S., as well as additional grants made in 2000, 2004, and 2009.

The Packard Foundation funded studies (in Journal Contraception) that claim self-managed abortion and reversing REMS is safe; the conflict of interest as an abortion pill investor was not noted.

Packard currently also funds Gynuity Health Projects, which conducts abortion pill clinical trials.
