Hebrews 13:1-6

Intro/Review:

Hebrews 12:25, 28–29

See that you do not refuse him who is speaking. For if they did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, much less will we escape if we reject him who warns from heaven. ... Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire.

1. In the Kingdom, we love and care for others.

Let brotherly love continue. Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares. Remember those who are in prison ... (v. 1-2)

- a. Love and Care for one another.
- b. Love and care for strangers.
- c. Love and care for the hurting & forgotten.

2. In the Kingdom, we understand and honor marriage.

Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous. (v. 4)

3. In the Kingdom, we trust the King to take care of us.

Keep your life free from love of money, and be content with what you have, for he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." (v. 5)
