**1. Our Hope is anchored**

**to Jesus' work as Great High Priest.** (6:19-7:10)

*We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner place behind the curtain, where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf, having become a high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.* (6:19-20)

→ How can Jesus be High Priest if he is from the tribe of Judah?

**2. Jesus' priesthood establishes**

**an indestructible hope.** (7:11-22)

*This becomes even more evident when another priest arises in the likeness of Melchizedek, who has become a priest, not on the basis of a legal requirement concerning bodily descent, but by the power of an indestructible life.* (Hebrews 7:15-16)

**3. Jesus saves "to the uttermost."**

(7:23-28)

*Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.* (v.25)
