SCRIPTURE: Daniel 6 TITLE: "Re-tell: Daniel"

Intro: Living in Exile. Strangers in foreign land. Under oppression & opposition. Daniel has royal blood. He's a prince in Israel. Earned respect of 3 foreign Kings! **Daniel** = "God is my judge." Daniel's name literally means: "Only God can judge me."

Main Themes of Daniel: (REPEAT AT END FOR CONCLUSION!)

- 1. God's Sovereignty over creation, creatures, kings and kingdoms.
- 2. How God's people can live as exiles in a pagan world under pagan rule.
- 3. Serve, live and follow world leaders and culture to the point of compromising principles.
- 4. God's kingdom is an eternal kingdom that will never fail or pass away.
- 5. Prayer is our primary weapon against persecution, hardship and our source for faith.
- 6. B/c God always keeps His promises. So we can live and trust Him through any situation.

Thesis: "We don't have to dare to be like Daniel, b/c Jesus was better than Daniel for us."

I. Living in Exile

- A. **Daniel believed God's promise** that the people would return & have freedom & home.
- B. Daniel was above reproach and thought well of by those in the society. Kings. Others.
- C. **Daniel still had enemies.** Will inevitably happen to those who are faithful. Enemies will be jealous of your respect. *Guilty conscience will cause them to hate your character.*
- D. Jeremiah 29:4-14*. And 1 Kings 8:33-34. How to live in exile. Pray. Practicals?
- E. Tipping well. Serving your neighbor (trash can, mail, dog, etc.). Work hard. No dirt.

ILLUSTRATION: Factory Workers. Both Christian. 1 Tim. 3:1-7.

F. Daniel was a man of regular prayer. 3x daily. He scheduled & had routine b/c it's needed.

APPLICATION: 1) Jesus was a stranger and treated like a stranger. He was faithful to God. 2) We're living and strangers and exiles. Sojourners. *This is not our home.* Why do we put so much stock on how things work here? Wealth. Stuff? Status? Health? *Homesick? Pray?*

II. Rescued from Destruction by Faith

- A. *Daniel already been praying* for Help. Out-loud. Knew what was coming. He knew. Daniel prayed & worship God when the government told him not to. Wasn't rebellion.
- B. Daniel slept better in the Lions Den than Darius had in his palace of luxury.
- C. Daniel was saved by faith. Hebrews 11:33. "stopped the mouths of lions."
- D. Daniel was saved by Jesus. "My God sent His Angel." v.22 He shut the mouths.

APPLICATION: 1) We're gonna be saved from destruction by faith too. Daniel was delivered from death because he was blameless. Jesus was delivered from death because he was blameless. We will be delivered from death because we will be found blameless in Christ.

2) Isaiah 11:6-9; 65:25. Heaven will be only peace. No death. Violence. Gore. Turmoil. Fights. Oppression. Injustice. Tension. Debates. Voting. Campaigning. Runoffs. Division. Restlessness.

3) Doesn't mean won't face hardship. Believers die. Killed & tortured. Some killed by lions.

III. God will receive glory through Jesus

- A. For his justice. Isaiah 66. Rev. 14:6-7 & Rev. 19.
- B. For his deliverance. "Lamb who was slain!" Purchased! Ransomed! Saved! Angels are amazed! *1 Peter 1:3-12*. Angels long to see this happen! Worship! Luke 2:8-14.
- C. From all nations. <u>v25-27</u>. Darius saw reality. *Gospel Preacher*. Command worship. Nations will hear and worship God. All languages and cultures and peoples. *VISION!*

1 KINGS 8

1 TIMOTHY 3
