SCRIPTURE: Ruth 4:13-22 TITLE: "Redemption: Applied"

Intro: Zoom. We only see a small piece of God's much bigger plan, purpose and picture.

Thesis: "The Lord will turn every bitter experience into sweet redemption for His people"

I. Redeemed by a Son (13-16)

- A. The Lord gave conception. Miraculous? 10 years! God did it! "A son is given."
- B. Naomi's Redeemer. This child your holding is your Redeemer/Savior. v.4:14
- C. His Name Renowned. Famous! "No other Name given on earth by which men must be saved..."
- D. He's a Restorer of Life. New life. Changed Life. Resurrected Life.
- E. He's Nourisher of the Elderly. "To live is Christ."
- F. He's a sign of the Lord's favor and grace. (So is Ruth). "Grace entered the world thru Jesus."
- G. Beautiful Sweet Image/Scene. Naomi takes boy, lays him in lap, cares for him.
 - 1. Bitter-Sweet Redemption. Mara? "Naomi, Naomi, Naomi" 3x. REPETITION!
 - 2. Cowper: "Bud may have a bitter taste, but sweet will be its flower."
 - 3. Naomi is caring for, nurturing her Redeemer/Savior. Mary.

II. Progress of Redemption (17-22)

- A. A Son born to Naomi? Or Ruth? Both. Yes.
- B. His Name is **Obed** = "Worker. Laborer. Servant."
- C. His Name shall be Jesus. Save His people from their sins. Lord Saves/Salvation.
- D. Virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and His Name will be **IMMANUEL**. God with us!
- E. Perez > Obed > Jesse > David!! Wait a second! That Obed? What?! MIND BLOWN!
- F. It's all connected! David > Solomon > Jesus.

ILLUSTRATION: **Pixar Cinematic Universe.** It's all connected. **// Disney Cinematic Universe.** Elsa and Anna are actually the older sister of Tarzan. Confirmed. What?! **Mind Blown!**

APPLICATION:

- 1. Bitter Sweet Redemptions:
 - a. Suffering and Sadness. Lord never left Naomi. He was always working//With her whole time.
 - b. Goodness of God. "All my life you have been faithful/so so good/all my days, held in your hands"
 - c. Sin/Temptations/Convictions/Repentance/Trials
 - d. **The CROSS.** Jesus's suffering/death/resurrection is Ultimate Bitter-Sweet Redemption. "Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross." That's the patter for the believer.

2. PROVIDENCE.

- a. John Piper. Book. Highlighter. Bible. Every Page. Whole Bible.
- b. Ruth is a prime example of God's providence in every small detail. ZOOM.
- 3. WHY? (Naomi's Story reminds us God can use/redeem our suffering and hard pasts, to help others.)
 - a. Kress. Born with Hydranencephaly. Why? Death of a son or child. Why?
 - b. Joni Erickson Tada. Why? Joni and friends.
 - c. Ed Welch. Father with severe depression. Hospitalized many times. His own anxiety. Why?
 - d. Teen Challenge. U-Turn 4 Christ. Reconciliation Ministries. Addictions. Broken families. Why?
 - e. Marcus Lattimore. Injured knee. Why? Coaching kids. Speaking for FCA.
 - f. Social anxiety from childhood. Share Group. Active siblings. Felt unseen/be good/easy. Why?

CONCLUSION:

- What's your Why? How is or will God use it. How does He want to use you and your story?
- We live in a sinful and fallen world. Impacted by our own sin, choices and the sin and choices of others. And whatever hardship we experience in our lives, God can use/redeem to help others.
