- 2. **Peace and Joy.** Sometimes you know someone has met Jesus. **GLORIOUS.**
- 3. **Loving others.** When they know the Love of Jesus. **GLORIOUS.**
- 4. **Serving.** Genuinely serve not wanting any return. Just to serve. **GLORIOUS.**
- 5. **Mercy, Grace, Kindness, Presence.** So **forgiving.** So **patient.** **GLORIOUS.**
 - a) *Spouse who forgives.* **GLORIOUS**
 - b) *Child who ask for forgiveness.* **GLORIOUS**
 - c) *A Worker who admits fault.* **GLORIOUS**
 - d) *Friendship reconciled and repaired. Communication reopened.* **GLORIOUS**
 - e) *Fun and Laughter. Laughing til you cry and crying til you laugh.* **GLORIOUS**
- 6. **When Justice is preserved.** Prisoners set free, criminals caught. **GLORIOUS.**
- 7. **Healing and Lives Saved.** Drs and medical intervention. Minutes. **GLORIOUS.**
- 8. **Wisdom Shared.** Lives guided. Advice taken. Counsel received. **GLORIOUS**
- 9. **Beautiful sunset.** Art. Beauty, Nature and creativity. **GLORIOUS.**
