- Joel began this series by asking us to suspend (not discard) some of our preconceived ideas, personal persuasions or past traditions about the Spirit of God. How have you traditionally viewed God's Spirit? What about the Spirit has guided you, or framed your view?
- 2. What if our "mystified" or "minimized" perspective of the Spirit of God is why we don't witness more evidence of the "supernatural" in our world? What do you think about this?
- 3. What do you think when something is recorded, written about, or witnessed something extraordinary or something that seems "beyond human?"
- 4. The complexity of creation, and the discoveries humans have made about our physical world (both astronomical and quantum) point to increasing complexities and layered relationships between them. How does Joel's explanation of the Spirit of God bringing order to chaos sit with you?
- 5. God's Spirit (ruach) represents His personal presence in the world today. How does your outlook on each day change knowing that?
