WEEK FOUR: AN IRRESISTIBLE CHURCH FOR THE WORLD

1. Our vision as a church is: To be an irresistible Church for our neighbors, the next generation and the world. As you take steps to take this personally, how have you seen God show up? What parts bring you the most tension?
2. Read Acts 1:1-11
3. What stands out to you?
4. The disciples asked Jesus “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?” Even though they followed Jesus for years, they still missed the point. Have you had times in your life you wanted God to do something but it didn’t exactly happen the way you wanted? How did that play out in your life and faith?
5. In Acts 1:8 Jesus gives them his final words before going up to heaven. Read that verse again and make it personal. What does it feel like to you to have Jesus invite you into his mission and purpose in the world?
6. Jesus invites His followers to be witnesses to Jerusalem (their city), Judea and Samaria (a little farther away) and the ends of the world. Sunday Jason connected those ideas with Jerusalem (our neighbors), Judea and Samaria (next generation) and the world. What part of that feels most challenging to you?
7. After those words from Jesus He leaves and ascends to heaven. His followers are left gawking at the sky. Do you ever feel that tension between “gawking” and “going”? What has it looked like in your life to see something that needs to be done and be a part of doing it?
8. What does it look like for you to take personally the mission of Jesus and the Vision of Anthem? Is God speaking? Asking? What if you said Yes to fully allowing God to use you? How can that be irresistible?
