Joshua and the Walls of Jericho Joshua 1-6

Key Scripture: Joshua 6:2

Then the Lord said to Joshua, "See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men."

Main Principle:

Trust in God's plan for your life. Don't let fear keep you from doing what God calls you to do.

Focus Points:

- Faith in God is trusting His plan for your life.
- Faith in God pushes fear out of your life.
- Submitting to God's plan for your life will bring great blessing to you.
- God will never leave you nor forsake you.

Group Questions:

- What important instructions did God give to Joshua when he commanded him to go in and take over the city of Jericho?
 Answer: God told Joshua to be strong and courageous and do not be afraid, for the Lord would be with him.
- 2. Why did the enemies in the Promised Land fear the Israelites?

 Answer: Their enemies had heard how the powerful and mighty hand of God was with the Israelites.
- 3. How many times and how many days did the Israelites march around the city of Jericho before the walls collapsed?
 Answer: They marched around the city once a day for six days and then on seventh day, they marched around the city seven times and then the walls collapsed.
- 4. What did God show Joshua and the people of Israel about his character?

 Answer: He would never leave them nor forsake them. They could always trust that he will do what he says he will do.
