

Bible Story Summary

- **God sent Paul to the city of Athens to tell people about Jesus.**
- **The people in Athens did not worship God. They worshiped false gods instead.**
- **Paul told the people about the one true God. He explained that God made everything, and that He is bigger than man-made false gods.**
- **He told them that God wants everyone in the world to repent, to turn away from their sin and turn to Him. God made all people, and they should all look to Him.**
- **When the people heard about Jesus being raised from the dead, some of them laughed. But some of them wanted to hear more. Those who listened to Paul believed in Jesus.**
