Group Questions

- 1. How did God help the Israelites know what direction to travel? Answer: By a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night.
- 2. How did the Israelite people react to Moses when they saw the Egyptian army coming after them?
 - Answer: They blamed Moses and told him that he should have just let them be slaves in Egypt instead of die in the desert. They were not grateful.
- 3. What did Moses tell the Israelites when they said this?
 Answer: He told them not to be afraid, but to stand still, and the Lord would fight for them!
- 4. What did God do for them after this? Answer: He caused a strong east wind to blow across the Red Sea and part the waters. The Israelites were then able to cross to the other side on dry ground.
