

The Ten Commandments Exodus 19-20

Key Scripture: Exodus 20:22

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Tell the Israelites this:

'You have seen for yourselves that I have spoken to you from heaven.'"

Main Principle:

Our actions, as well as our words, must reveal our faith and trust in God.

Focus Points:

1. The commandments of God never change.
2. The commandments keep us safe and protected in our walk with God.
3. Our words and actions reveal our faith and trust in God.
4. God will never fail us.

Group Questions:

1. Who did God choose to reveal the 10 Commandments to?
Answer: He called Moses and then Moses gave them to the Israelite people.
2. What caused the Israelites to fear God and put their trust in Him?
Answer: The mighty and powerful works of God. Ex: The 10 Plagues, parting the waters of the Red Sea, the death of all the Egyptian army as they pursued the Israelites into the sea, taking care of them in the desert, etc.
3. What did God ask of the Israelites when He told them that they were His treasured possession and would make them His holy nation?
Answer: He wanted them to obey His voice and keep His commandments.
4. Write down a list of words describing all the characteristics of Moses.
Ex. brave, strong, etc.
