## Bible Story Summary

- Paul was with the church in Antioch.
- God chose Paul and Barnabas to travel and tell the good news about Jesus to not only the Jews, but the Gentiles.
- Paul and Barnabas traveled to Lystra, and Paul healed a man there who was lame. The
  people saw what Paul had done, and they thought Paul and Barnabas were gods.
- Paul told them that they were men just like them.
- He told them they had come to tell them about Jesus.
- This made some people made and they kicked Paul and Barnabas out of the city.
- The next day, Paul and Barnabas went to the city of Derbe. They told people there about Jesus, and many people believed.
- Then they went back to Lystra and to Iconium to encourage the believers there.
- Finally, Paul and Barnabas returned to the church at Antioch. They reported everything God had done on their journey and how God had helped them share the good news with the Gentiles.

## Family Discussion Questions As a family read Acts 13:1-3; 14

- Why did Paul and Barnabas leave Antioch?
- How did Paul and Barnabas react to the people who tried to worship them?
- Why is it important to tell others about Jesus?

## Suggested instructions:

Talk about how sometimes following instructions can seem hard when you don't know the end goal. Paul and Barnabas obeyed God even when they didn't know exactly where He would lead them next.
