Prayer Word: Strength (Week 3) by Pastor Carl



Have you cried at a wedding or at a baby's birth or a movie? Have you ever laughed at a comedian or a well-told joke? Our emotional strength gives us resilience to get through challenging experiences, to experience joy in our daily lives, and respond to the myriad of things that occur each day. Our mental and emotional bodies work together to help us live in society. Some people react emotionally before thinking about the situation or context. Other people sometimes appear cold as they mentally prepare responses that manage or conceal their emotions. Jesus responded to the moneychangers in the Temple by overturning their tables and chasing out the animals. Many see this as an emotional outburst from Jesus, but with Jesus' emotional strength, we should probably understand it as a demonstration of his feelings and sense of urgency at causing them to leave.

Our emotional strength needs to be exercised to be able to manage emotionally strong events in our personal lives and simultaneously have empathy and compassion for those who are experiencing events even if they are strangers to us. God tells us to love our neighbors and our neighbors are those who are in need.




