




Our food pantry needs:


WHAT'S NEXT?

A number of things going on behind the scenes as the year progresses.

1. Repairs to the Activity Center roof and re-coating the flat roof is looking like a cost of \$8,400.00 which will need to be done in the next month to avoid further damage to the building. (This is not attributable to storm damage per se but to the age of the building)

2. The floor of the gymnasium is showing "bubbles" that is due to water coming up from beneath the flooring. At the moment we are keeping an eye on this and have "bled" the water from the bubbles to avoid and further damage.

3.We have ordered and received a new reverse osmosis filtering system for the fellowship hall kitchen. Unfortunately, we had to delay installation until some broken in shipment part can be reshipped to us.

4.We have ordered and received new door handles for the pre-school classroom doors that were worn out and not working properly. These will be installed once they have been re-keyed.

5.We have been installing new motion censors in the bathrooms of our buildings to avoid having lights left on overnight.

With our aging campus we are faced with a need to support our church with our gifts of money, of our time, of our service to others. WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT

Sheila King and James Harper were nominated and approved as Lay delegates to the Desert Southwest Conference Annual Conference in June. This year it will be held in Tucson for the first time. Anyone may attend, but voting is limited to approved delegates.

We adjusted our 2024 budget to account for the actual apportionment requirement – it went up \$627 for the year to a total of \$45,898. Our apportionment enables us to support the worldwide ministries of the United Methodist Church. As a reminder, the budget is a plan that provides authority to spend. The Finance Committee then must raise the funds to meet the plan.
