

LAY SERVANT MINISTRIES

Lay Servant Ministries of the South District will be offering two Basic Classes (Introduction to Lay Ministry) in the near future. 
Helping Hands Tutoring

Thanks to all who set up a table at the Ministry Fair. We truly have something for everyone.

We discussed the draft 2026 church budget. Total authority is about \$700,000. You will vote on this budget at the Church Conference on 1 November. If you have specific questions, drop me an email and we will discuss. This is your church budget, and you should be comfortable with the priorities it supports.

Today, September 5th, we start our new relationship with the Southern Arizona Food Bank. This is different from our food pantry and our monthly Market on the Move ministries. Help is always needed.

The Trustees are busy keeping our campus in working order. They are getting bids to replace the ancient water heaters in the Fellowship Hall, upgrading our phones and internet (at a lower cost!), and reworking the fee structure for outside groups that use our campus. They are also working with an outside consultant to maximize our property insurance claims.

The Finance team has gained a credit card for use not only by the office manager but also to streamline purchases for our food pantry.

The Staff/Parrish Relations Committee combined the office manager and bookkeeper positions and made it a full-time position. This will provide stability and gain some efficiency in the office. Also, Rev Kayla is shifting from 75% Village Christian Pre-School director and 25% associate pastor, to a 50/50 work split. Many of her new SVUMC duties will include outreach events.

Under new business, we amended the 2025 church budget to account for compensation differences between our old and new senior pastor and changes with the office manager and bookkeeper positions. This actually dropped our total 2025 budget authority over \$3000 to a new total of about \$692,000. We also agreed to start planning a craft Fair in the Spring.

Our next meeting will be September 25th, 5:30 PM in the Serenity Room. All are welcome.
