

Prayer Word: Courage (Week 2) by Pastor Carl



Courage is strength in the face of pain or grief. When we believe in the good news of Jesus Christ, that the gates of Heaven are open to us and God is near, we can profess that faith and be carried through even the darkest times in our lives. It sometimes appears that there are two types of people: those who dislike change and those who are constantly changing things. What is interesting is that sometimes those are the same person. For example, we like to eat different things for our meals (change the meal or venue) but we eat at the same time every day (our schedule never changes). It takes courage and fortitude (strength) to change established habits and move out of our comfort zones. Jesus challenges our comfort zones, because sometimes our comfort zones cause other people discomfort (and sometimes even inflict pain or hardship). How can we expect God to transform the face of the earth if we are not changed by our encounter with Jesus Christ?






LENT BIBLE STUDY

We will also elect UMM Fishermen officers for the 2024.




Crossroads Adult Sunday School




