

Prayer Word: Perserverence (Week1) by Pastor Carl



A professor at Asbury Theological Seminary was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis (MS) about 20 years ago. The doctors were not very encouraging with details about her case, telling her that given her age and the aggressive nature of the disease in her she would likely be unable to walk in two to three years. These 20 years later she still walks – most days she walks about 5 miles though she admits that some days she is barely able to walk from the parking lot to the classroom. Despite the diagnosis, she has persevered to maintain a normal way of life as the disease slowly takes its toll. She is content with the knowledge that she has held it at bay nearly 10 times as long as doctors expected. She knows that the Holy Spirit guides her daily and strengthens her when she feels weak. She shares with her classes that her disease has made her stronger in her faith as she relies on God to get her through the days. There are struggles to perseverance, but confidence in the Holy Spirit working within us gives us the strength to see things through. Engaging with God instead of blaming God for the hardships lead to spiritual growth.


