

Cochise county registered voters will vote on whether our sales tax should be increased by 0.5% for a limited time, in order to finance a new jail.


If you want to vote early in person: early voting has now started, and will continue until Friday, October 31. The early voting site is the Recorder's office in Bisbee, open M-F, 8-5. You will need to bring required identification.

If you are not on the Active Early Voter List and wish a mailed ballot for this election, you must request one by today, October 24. Request it from the Cochise County Recorder: 520-432-8350 or online at my.arizona.vote.

Mailed ballots have been sent. You may:

- (a) mail them back up to October 28 (to ensure arrival by election day),
- (b) drop them off in Sierra Vista at the county service center, 4001 E Foothills Dr. (M-F, 8-5, through Oct. 31),
- (c) drop them off at any county polling place on November 4.


