## **Food Pantry Update**





Our Helping Hands tutoring program works to help Huachuca Mountain Elementary students improve their reading skills. As a part of that, they are incorporating two simple activities – hopscotch and jumping rope. Both activities significantly contribute to their physical, cognitive, emotional, and social development. They provide a fun, engaging way to practice fundamental skills essential for both playground success and academic work.

Several of our tutors have affirmed hopscotch, jumping rope, and skipping as supporting whole-brain communication, vital for higher-level thinking," comments Dixie Lee Larson.
