Community Food Bank

Sierra Vista United Methodist Church is proud to announce that we have been accepted as a partner with Tucson Community Food Bank to assist our neighbors in Cochise County with food insecurities. For several months a team has been working with the Food Bank and soon all will be in place to make this ministry happen. One morning a month the commodities will be delivered to SVUMC and distributed that same morning. This program is different than others because there is absolutely no charge. The food boxes will also contain fresh and frozen protein such as meats and cheeses. The only requirement is proof of residency. The number of boxes going to each family is based on the size of the family.

As with all ministries, volunteers are necessary to make this happen. The commitment is only 3 to 4 hours per month. Training in food handling is being provided by the Community Food Bank Friday, July 25 at 10 a.m. in the Serenity Room. If you are at all interested in volunteering now or in the future, please consider attending this training.
