

## Prayer Word: Inclusion (Week 2) by Pastor Carl



Deuteronomy 23 instructs the people of Israel that Moabites are bad and they should not dwell among God's people. Yet the story of Ruth the Moabite challenges the prejudice against Moabites. Ruth is a model of loyalty, kindness, and faithfulness. Ruth's actions demonstrate integrity and deep commitment to her Israelite family and to God. Her inclusion in the genealogy of King David, and ultimately the line of Jesus, emphasizes that God values character over ethnicity. The narrative shows that foreigners, even those from historically antagonistic groups, can be part of God's redemptive plan. Some would be eager to point out that Ruth had been fully acculturated into Israelite life, yet she was still termed "the Moabite" and viewed as an outsider. What must change for an outsider to be fully included and no longer be an outsider?



Coffee is ready by 7:30 AM and and the Gathering kicks offat 8:00 AM with breakfast in the Fellowship Hall. Ladies are welcome.




#### COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT



# Health and Exercise Classes


Strength Training classes are offered by Nancy Buttke in the Fellowship Hall on Mondays and Fridays as shown on the chart below.
