


Looking for Party bridge players. We hope to start playing on Wednesdays in the fellowship hall from 1 to 4 once we find interested players (we need 4 for each table).



Don't we have some cool Trustees? The Trustees led the effort on the Worship Center air conditioning and vou responded fabulously to pay for it! On 28 July, the Church Council increased the 2024 budget authority in order to install the A/C. Next up, our cool Trustees will repair our ice machine in the Activity Center.

Speaking of the budget, the Finance Committee sent the draft 2025 church budget to the Church Council to endorse and send to the Church Conference on 21 September for you to approve. Your budget establishes priorities and authorizes expenditure of your financial resources. 2025 is an increase over 2024, from \$634,245.41 to \$691, 191.92. There are several ups and owns across the 100 budget lines, but almost all of the net increase is in human resources and comes with an income source. Rev Kayla is our Director of Christian Education and the Director of Village Christian Preschool. Before she was commissioned this year at Annual Conference (way to go, Rev Kayla!) she got separate paychecks from the church and the school. She now gets one paycheck from the church, and the preschool pays 3/4 of the total. The budget is not simple, and if you would like details, please contact me and we'll sit down. Our budget is public and there are no secrets.

While not strictly a Church Council event, we had our annual Strategic Planning retreat on 16-17 August. We updated our plan and you will hear more at Church Conference.

Our next meeting will be September 26th, 5:30 PM in the Serenity Room. All are welcome.

# Health and Exercise Classes


Strength Training classes are offered by Nancy Buttke in the Fellowship Hall on Mondays and Fridays as shown on the chart below.
